Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 6.8%** since 2019, falling by 858. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.7%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 79.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 4.2%** in Haskell County, OK from 4,119 to **3,946**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 8.3%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 48.1% to 50.1% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.8% of Haskell County, OK residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.7% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Individual and Family Services.

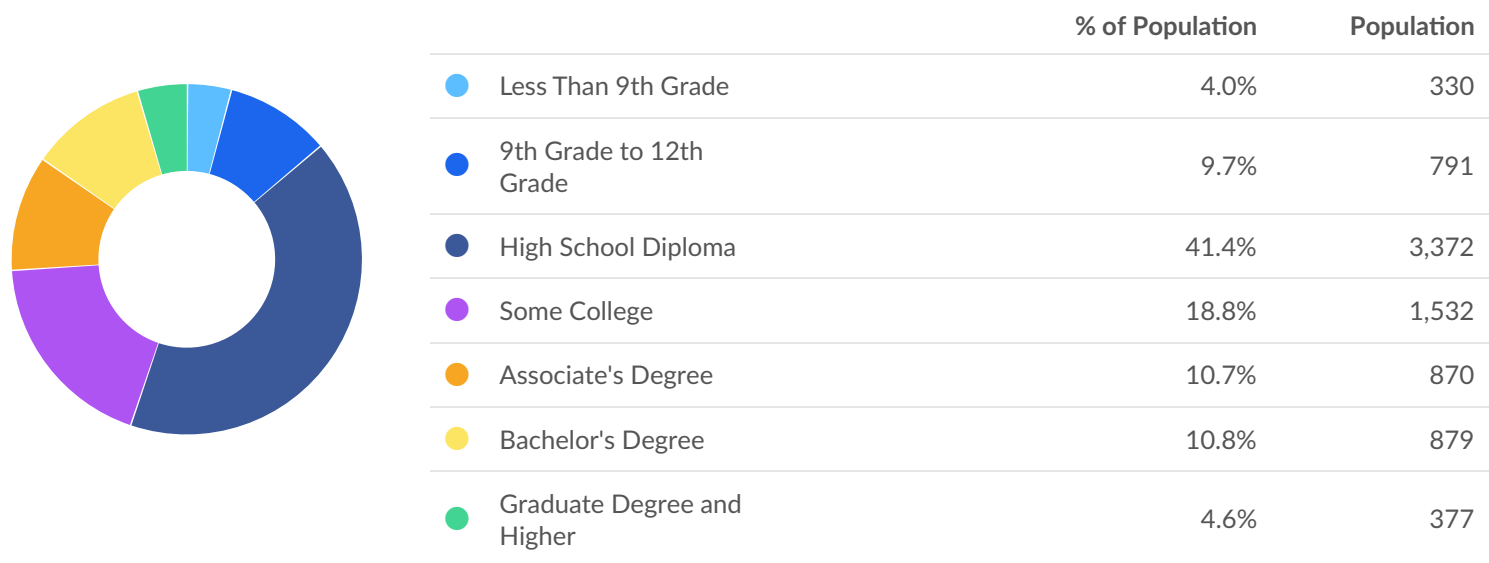

Apr 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



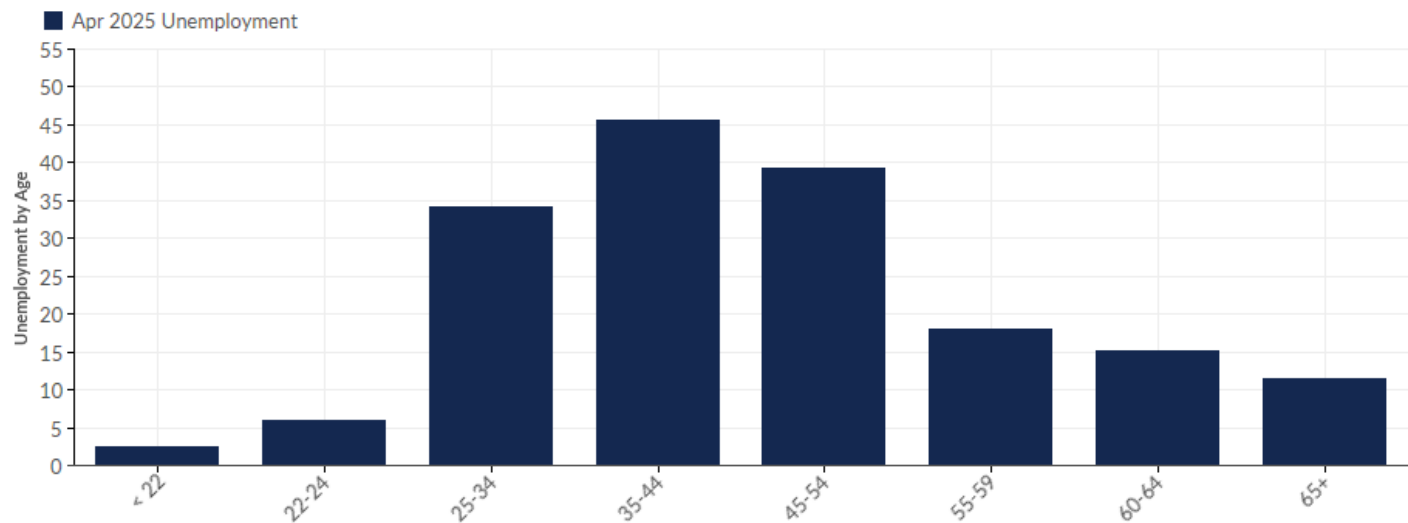
Educational Attainment

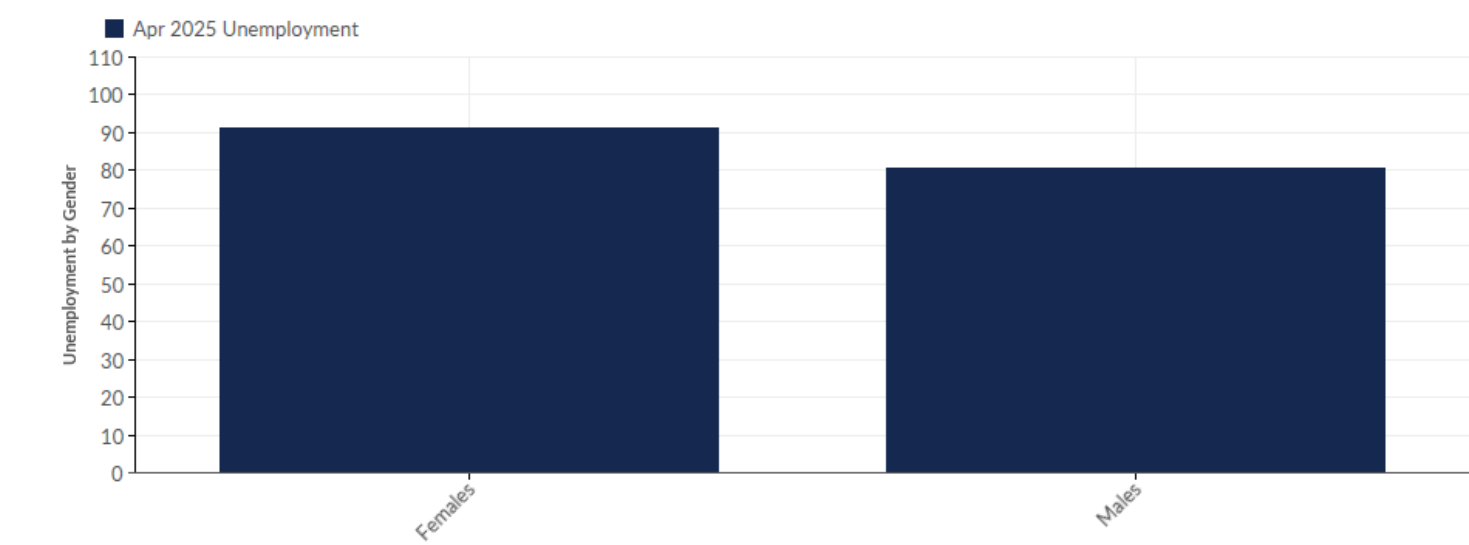

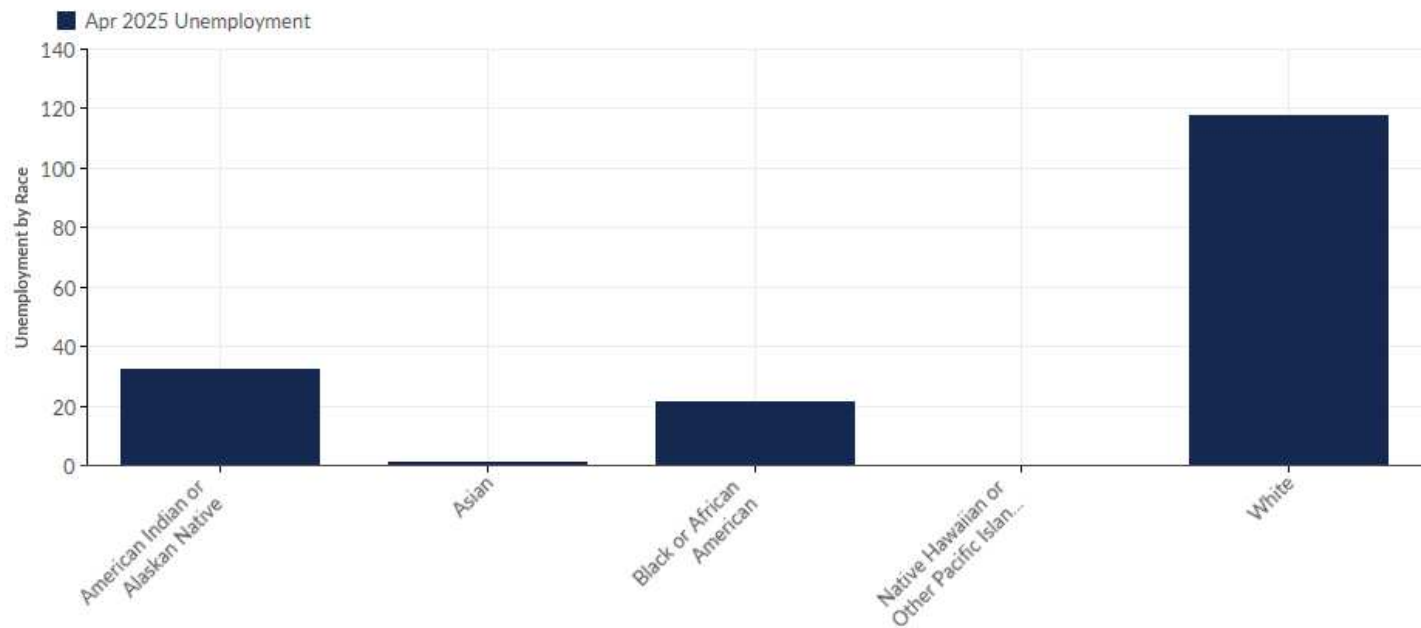

Unemployment by Gender



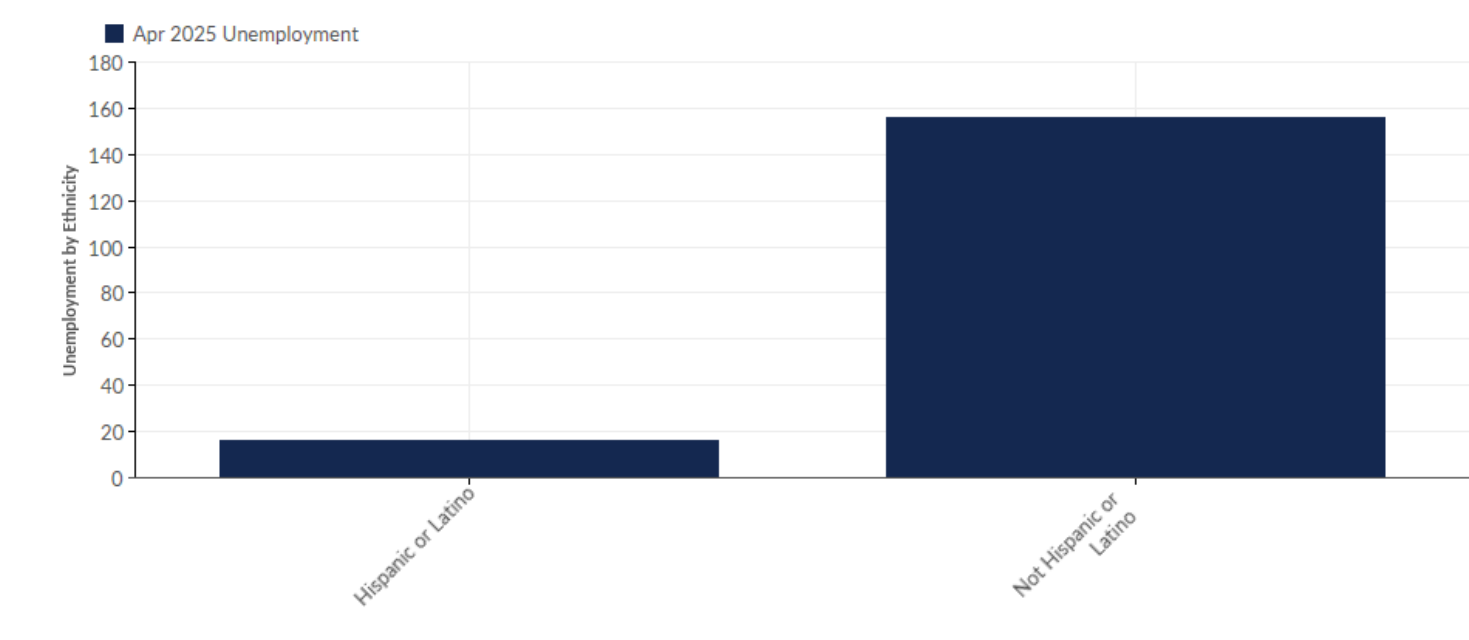

Unemployment by Ethnicity

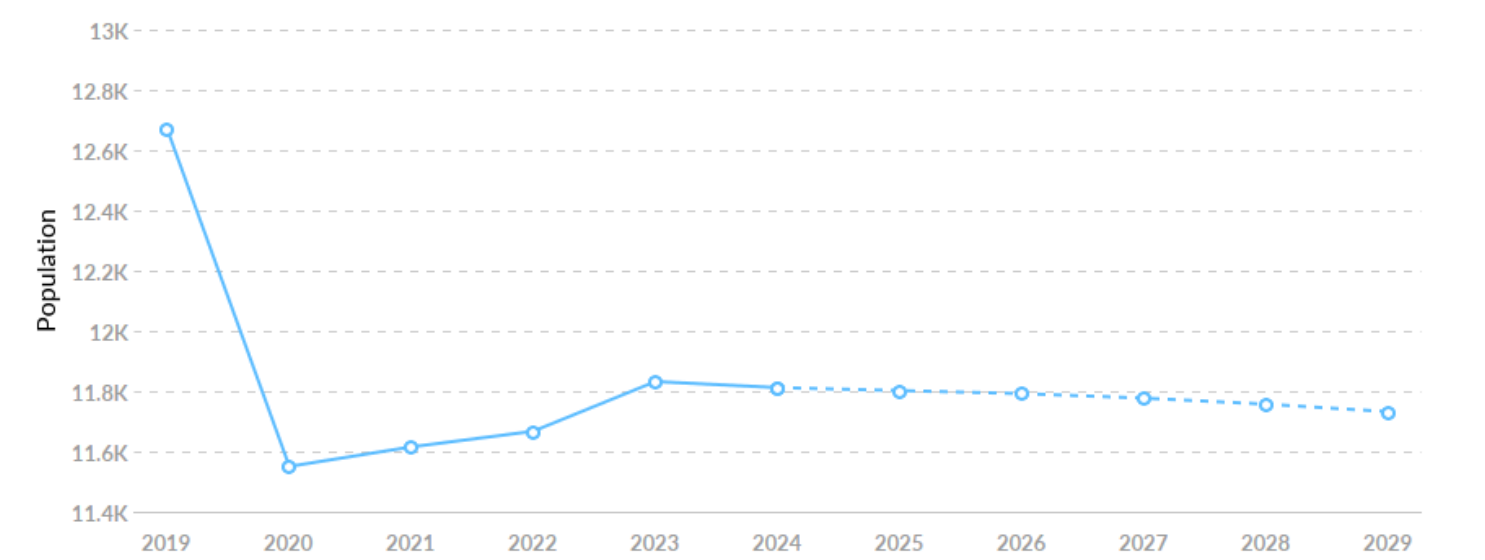

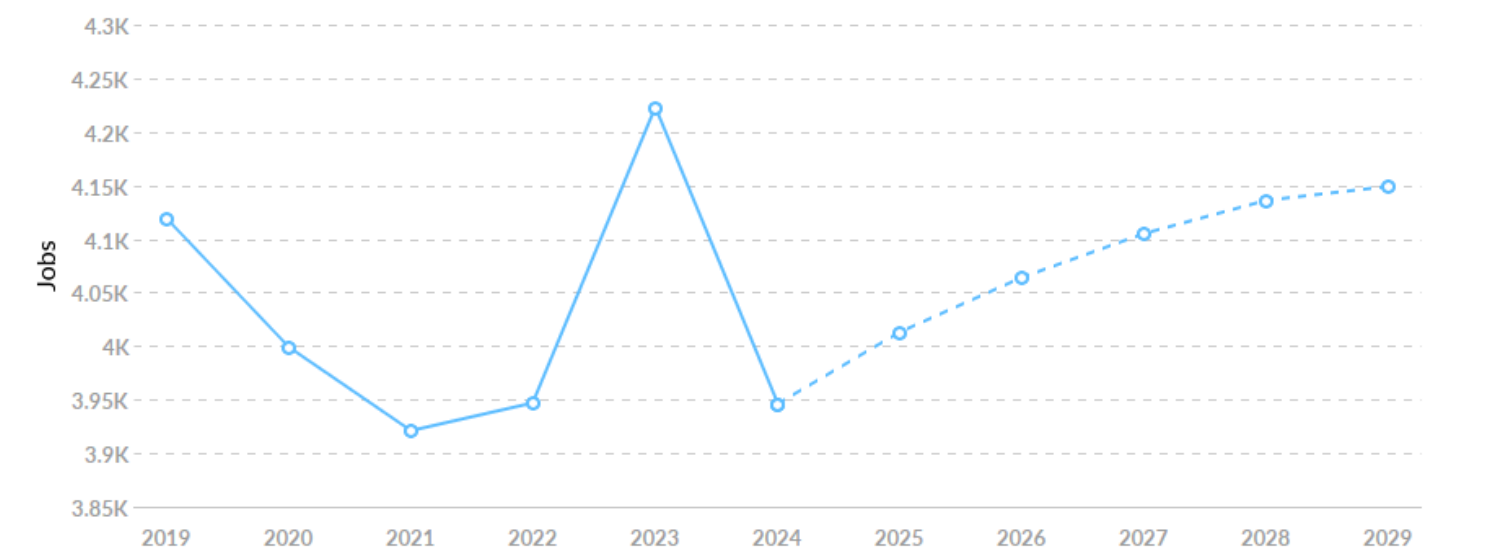

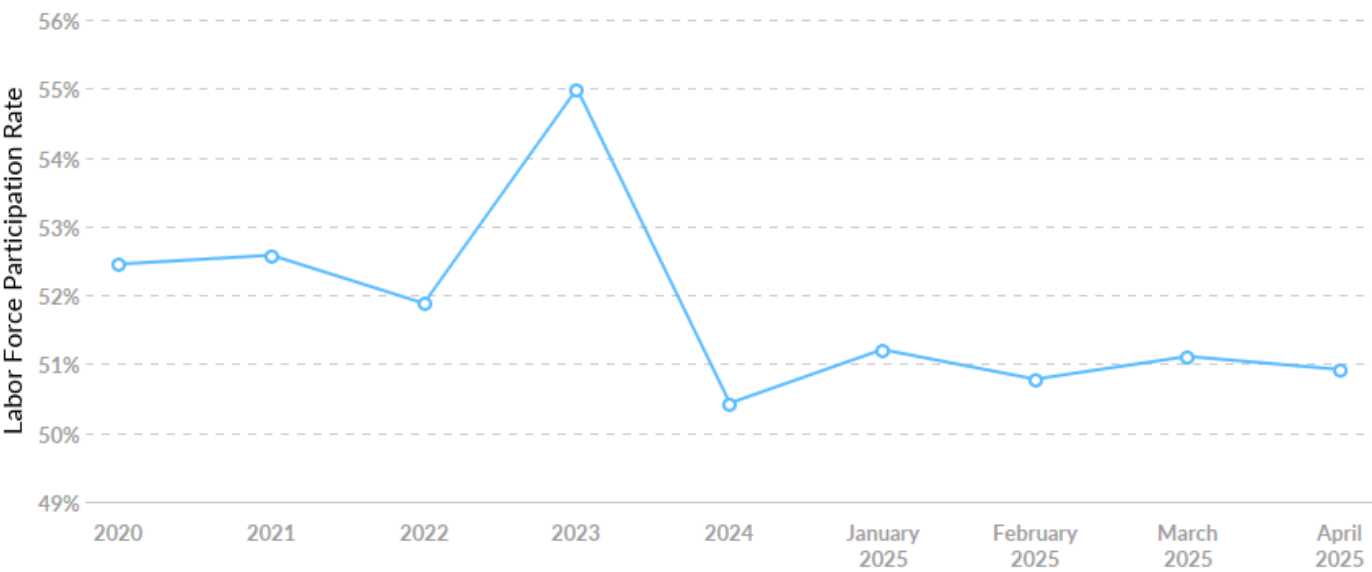
Job Trends

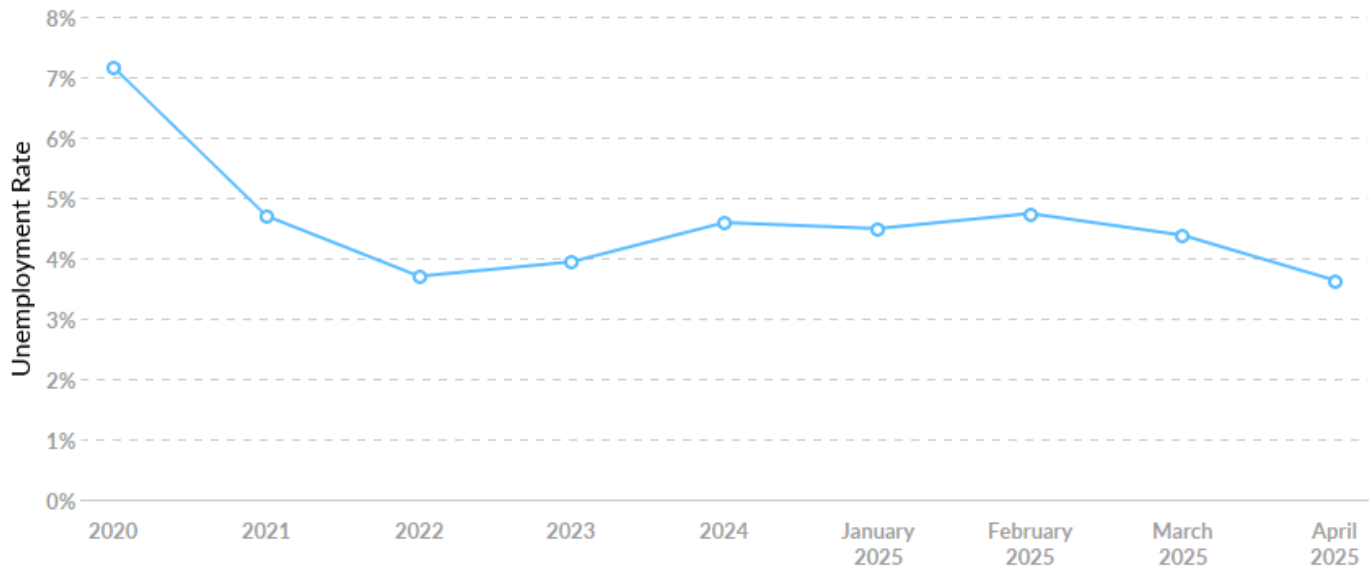

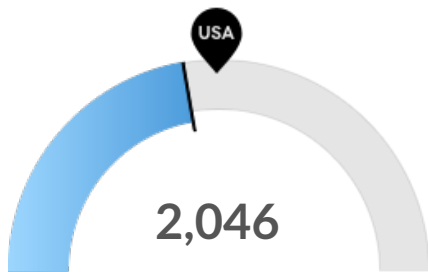
Unemployment Rate Trends

Haskell County, OK had an April 2025 unemployment rate of 3.63%, **decreasing from 7.16%** 5 years before.



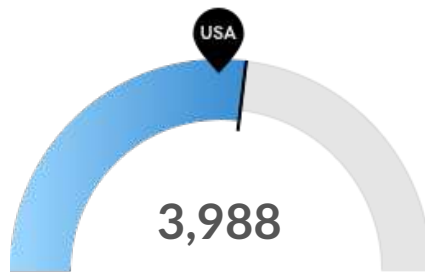

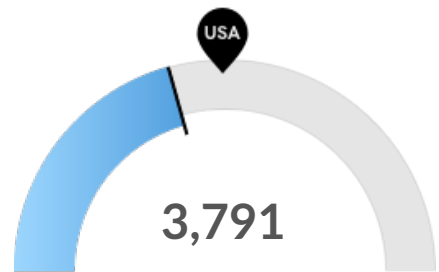
Millennials

Haskell County, OK has 2,046 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,404.



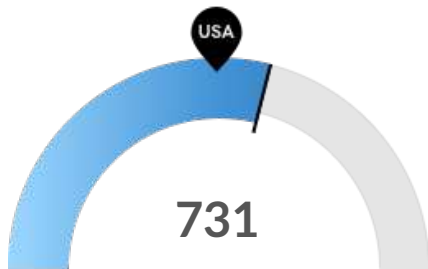
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Haskell County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 3,572 people 55 or older, while there are 3,988 here.



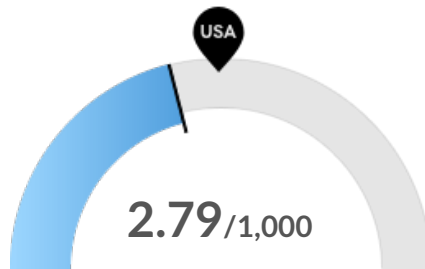
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Haskell County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 4,928 racially diverse people, while there are 3,791 here.



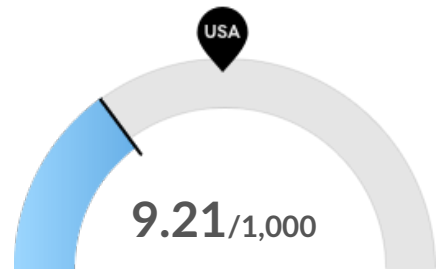
Veterans

Violent Crime

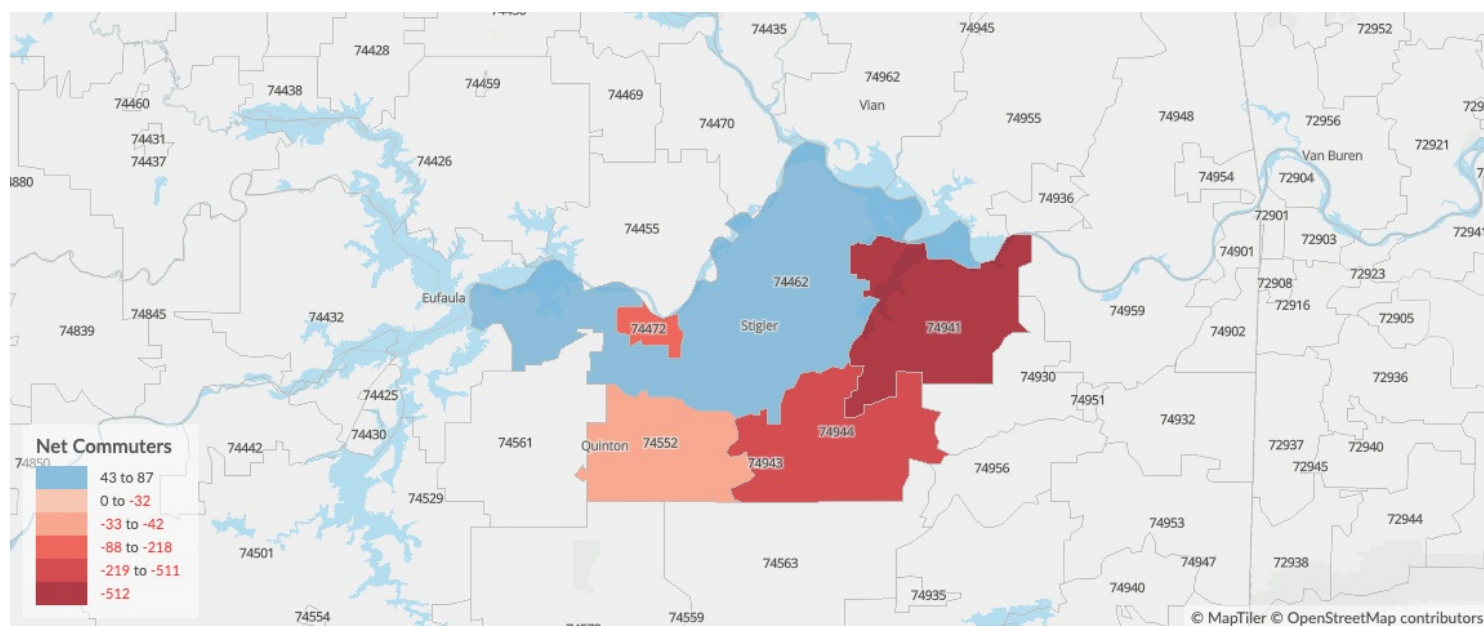
Haskell County, OK has 2.79 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

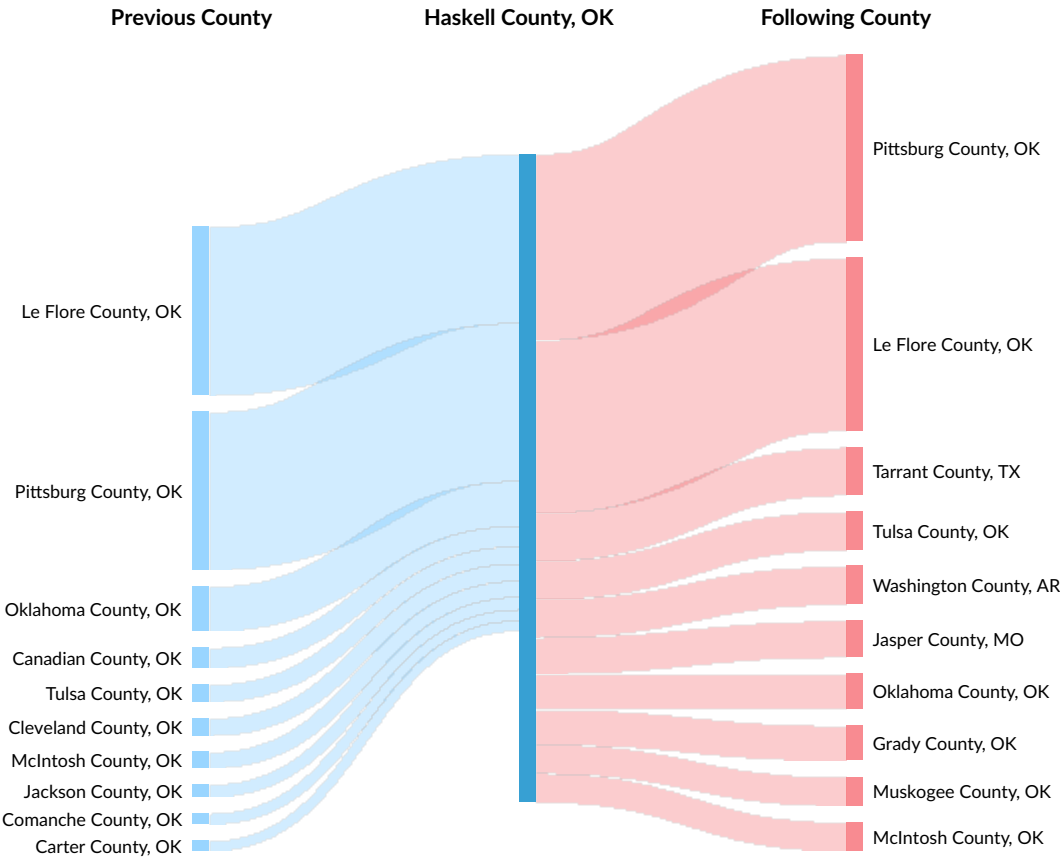

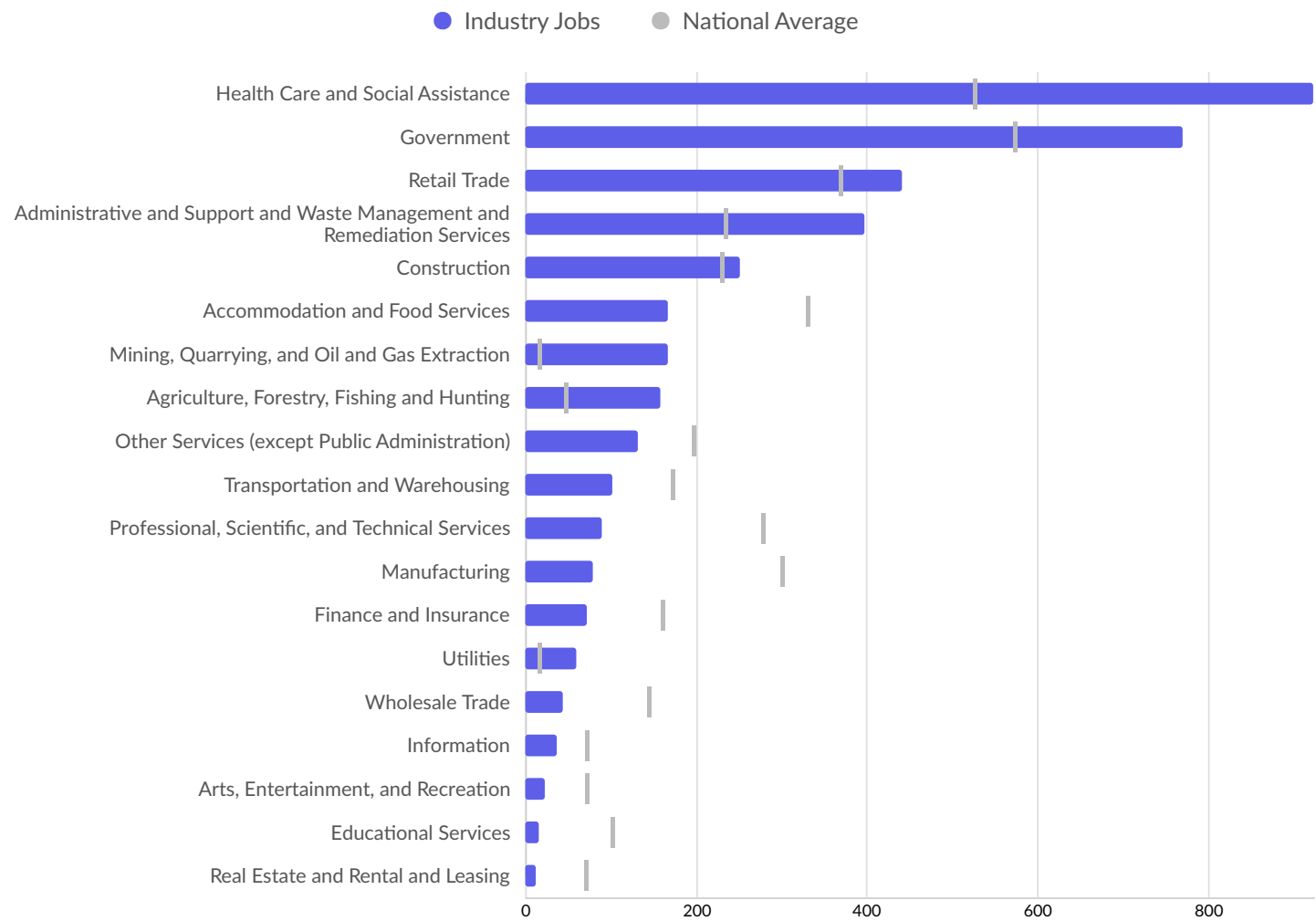

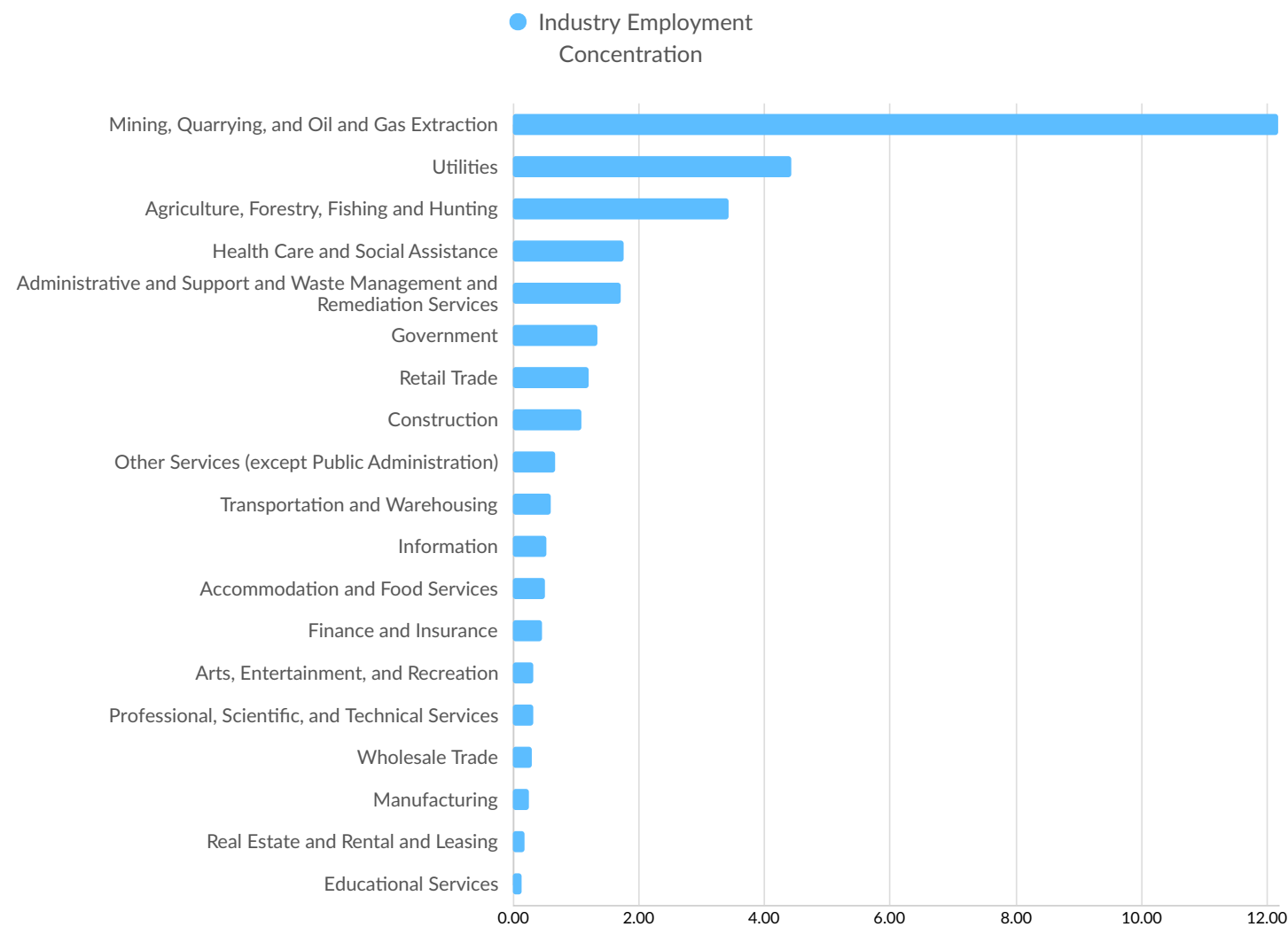

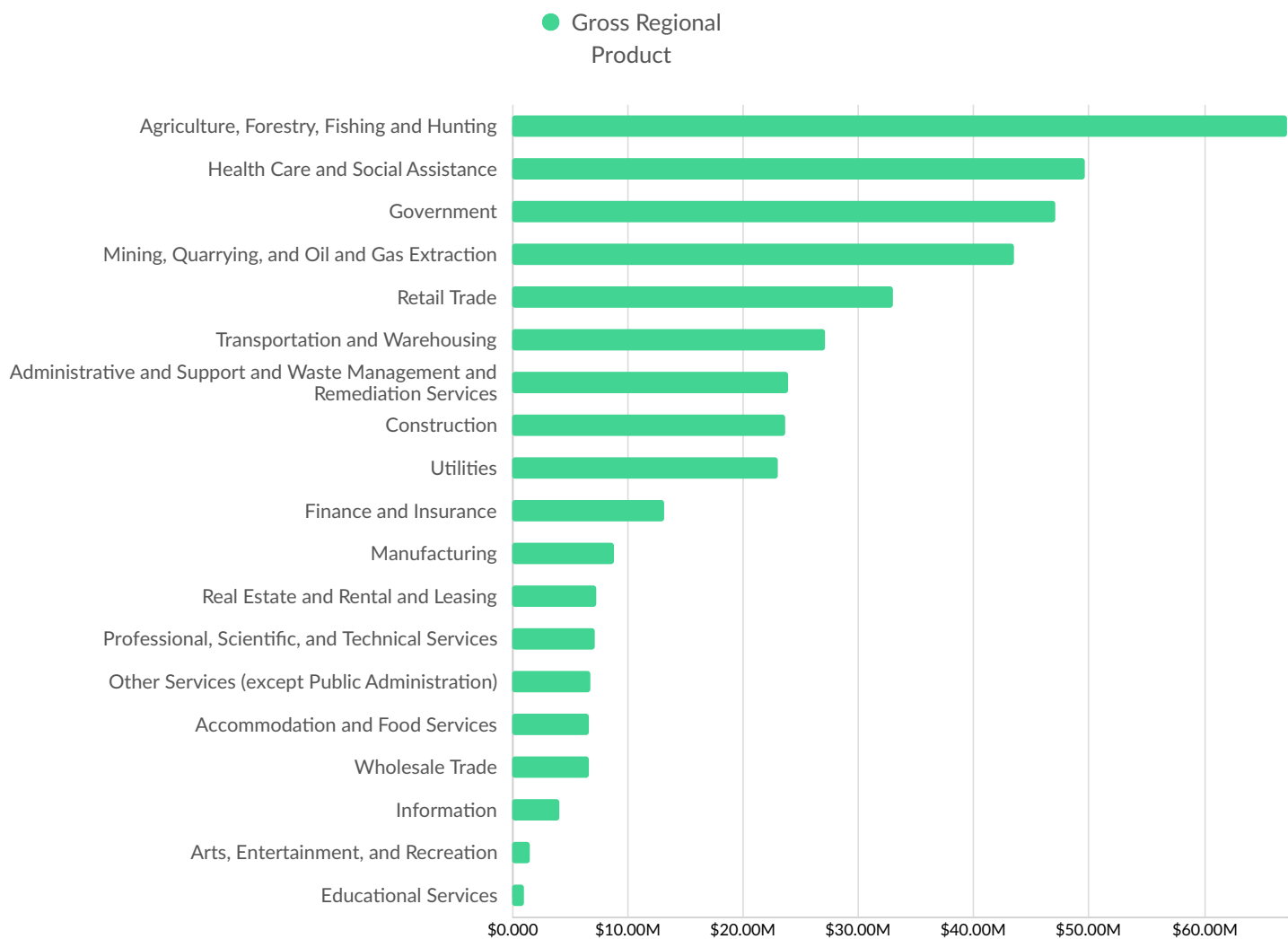
Top Growing Industries



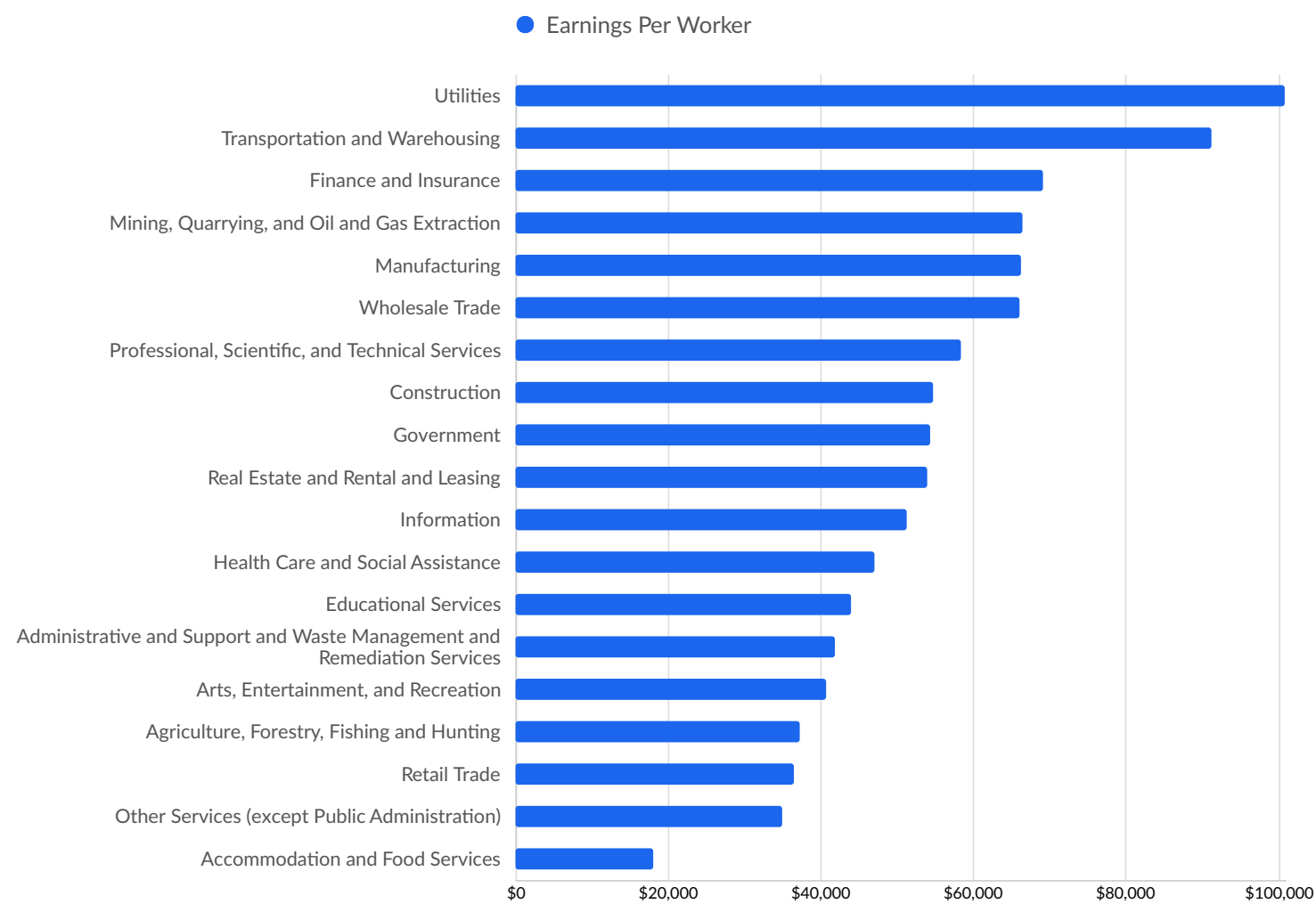
Top Industry Employment Concentration

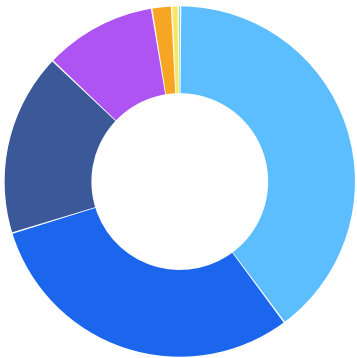

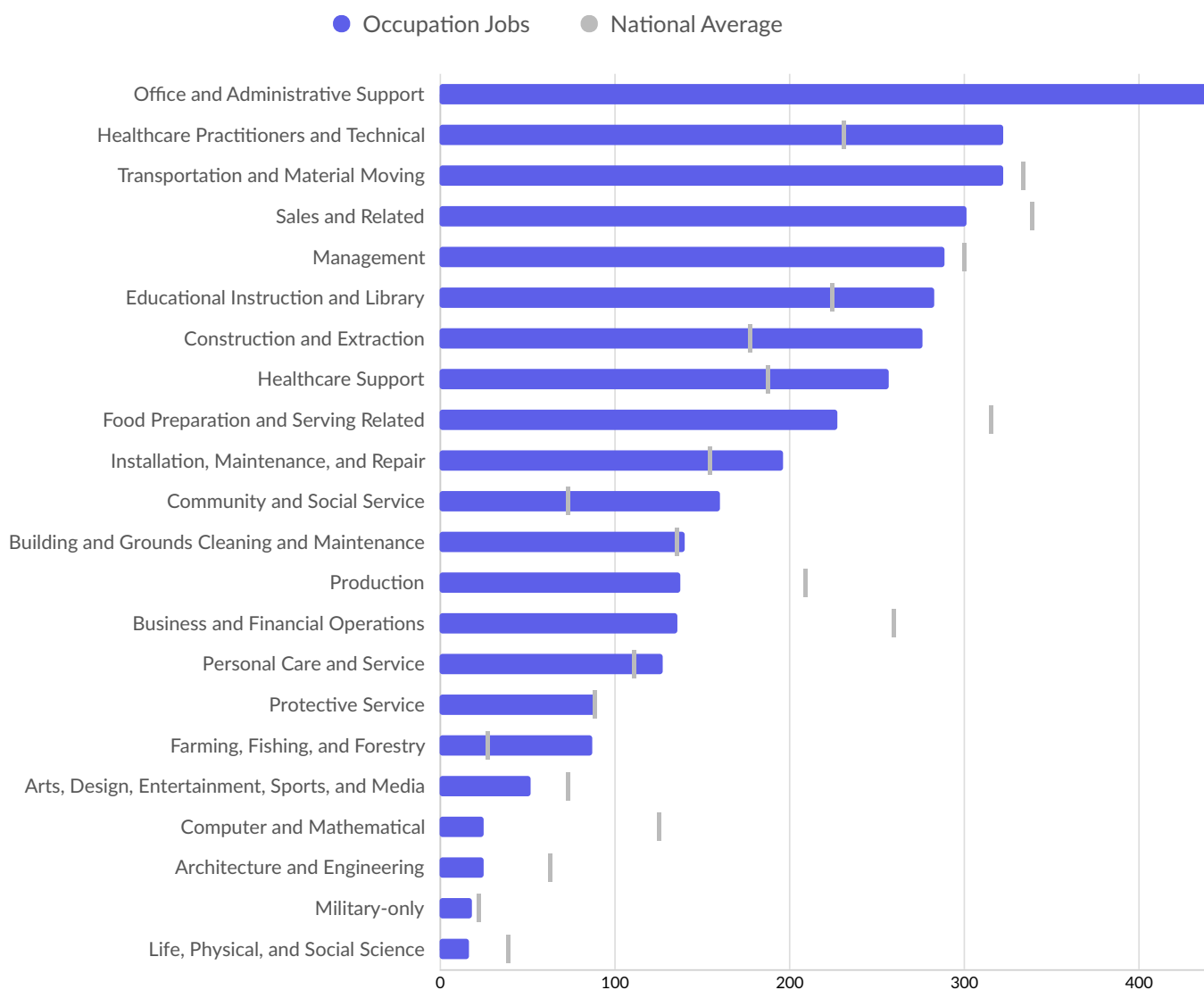

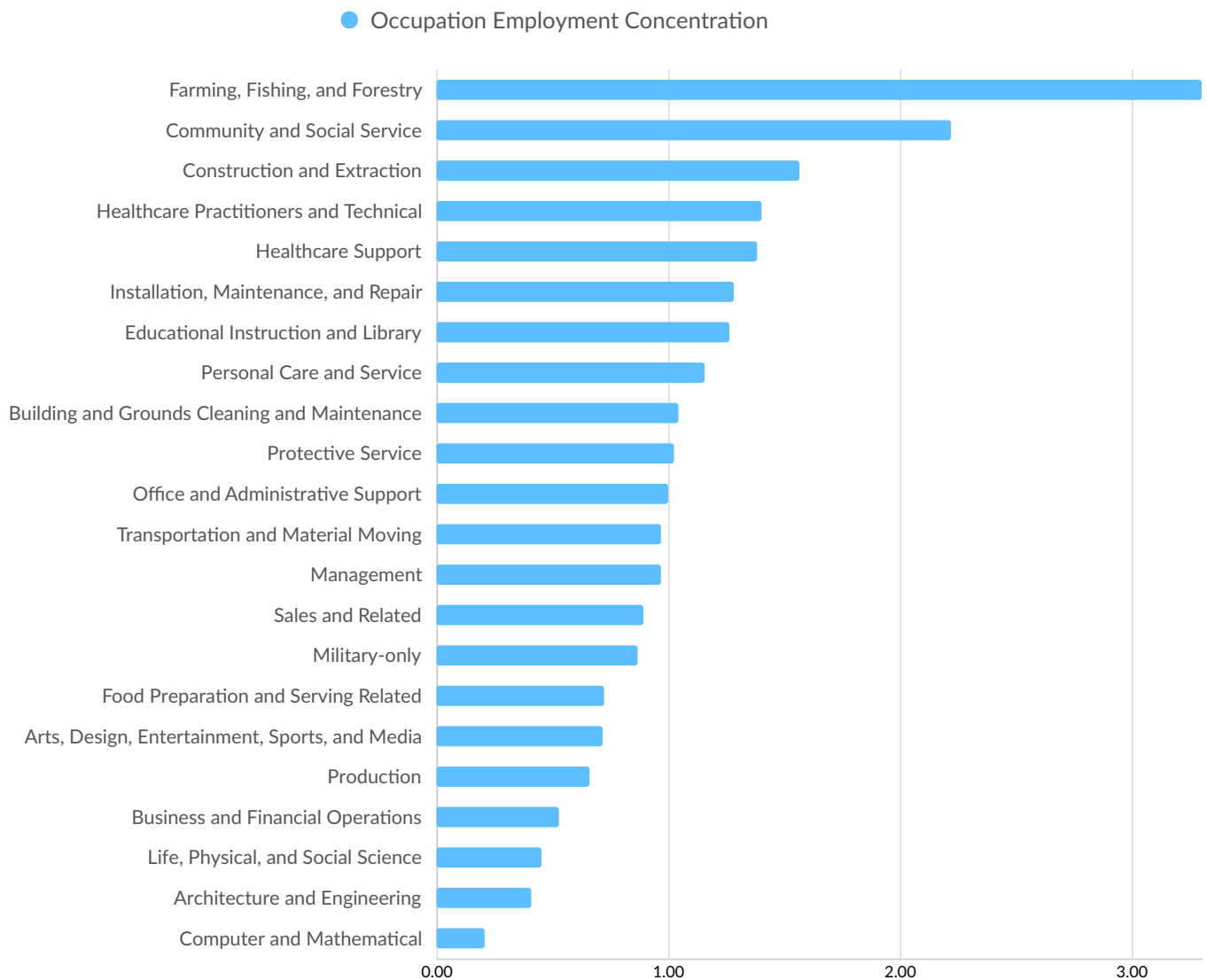

Top Growing Occupations



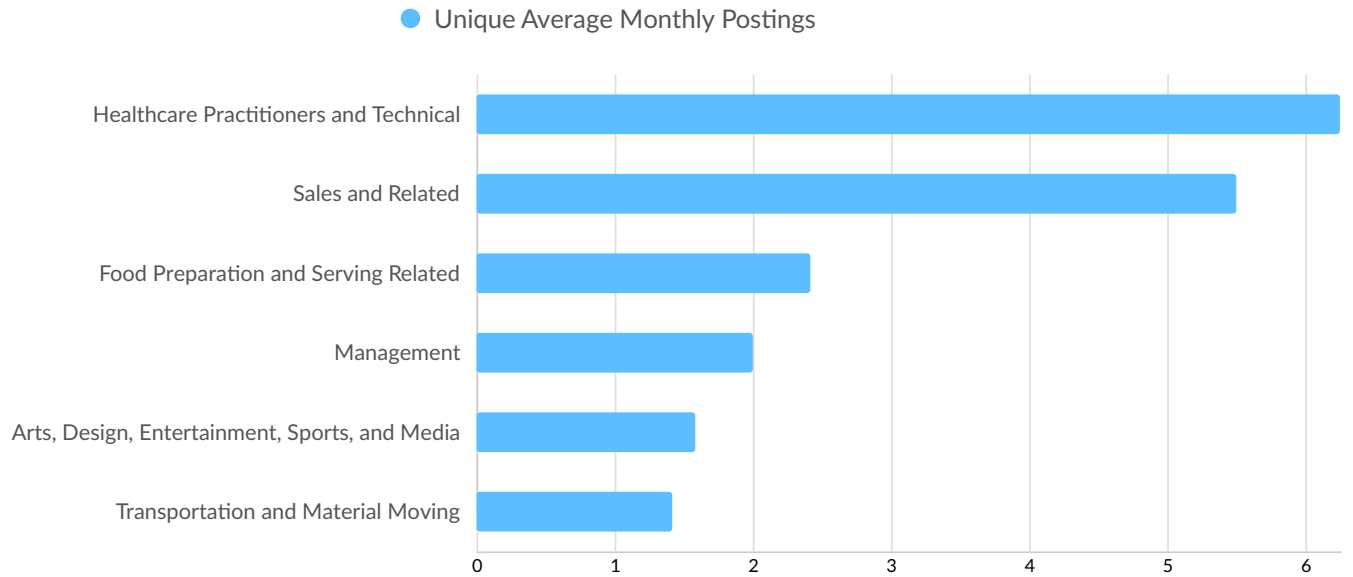
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



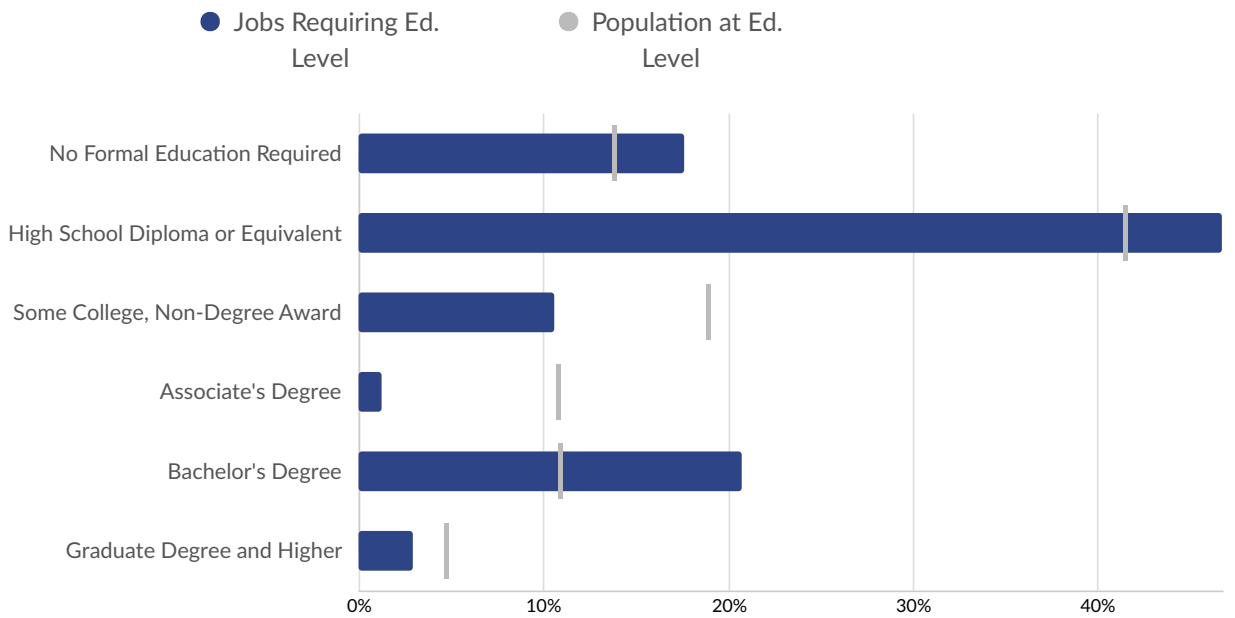
