


Median household income is **\$28.4K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 7.2%** since 2019, falling by 2,372. Population is expected to **decrease by 3.4%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 1,046.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 9.3%** in McCurtain County, OK from 12,693 to **13,869**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.1% by 5.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 52.9% to 63.0% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of McCurtain County, OK residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.7% below the national average), and **7.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



Apr 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment


Unemployment by Demographics



Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity






Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

McCurtain County, OK had an April 2025 unemployment rate of 2.90%, decreasing from 7.22% 5 years before.





McCurtain County, OK has 5,682 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,230.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in McCurtain County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 9,256 people 55 or older, while there are 9,130 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in McCurtain County, OK. The national average for an area this size is 12,769 racially diverse people, while there are 12,583 here.




Veterans

McCurtain County, OK has 3 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings

● Median Hourly Earnings




Top Posted Occupations

● Unique Average Monthly Postings


