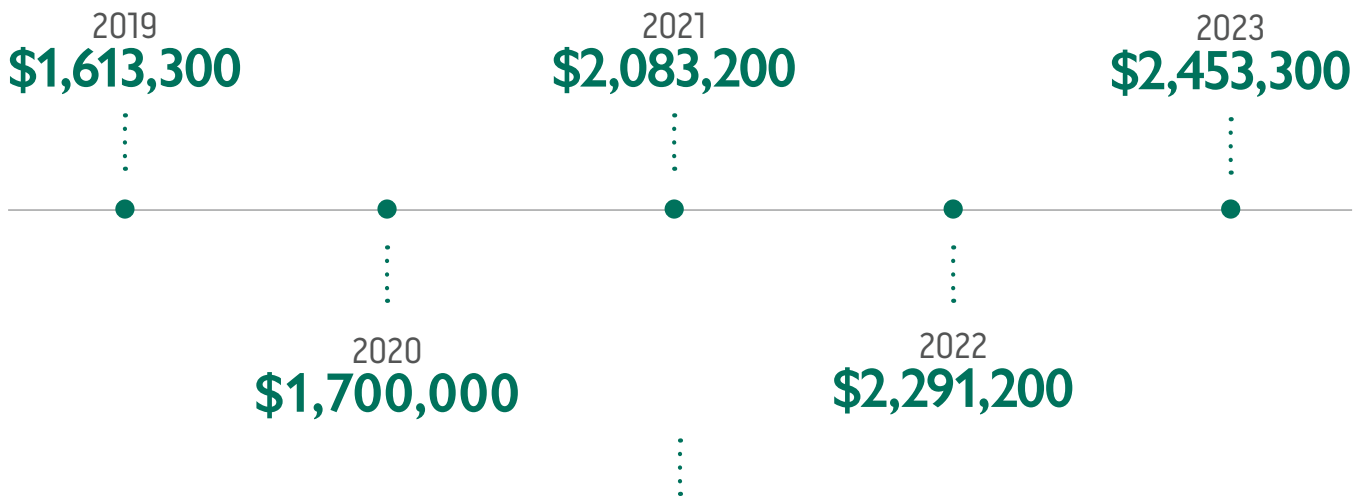


MISSION
