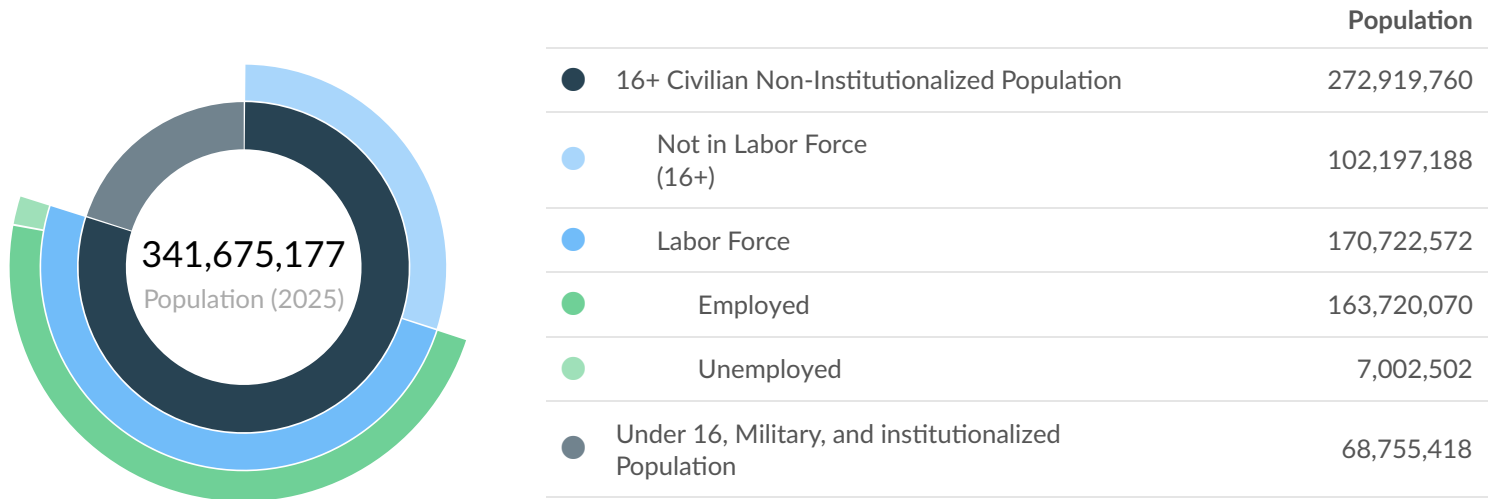

- The top three industries in 2025 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

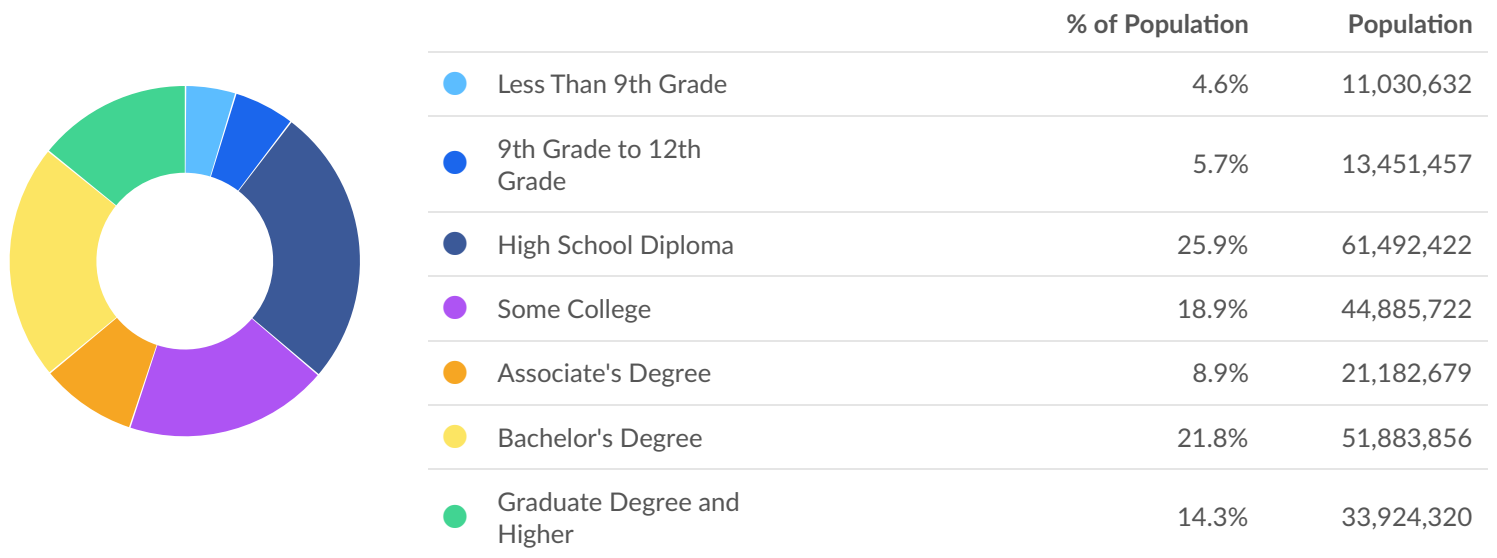

Dec 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



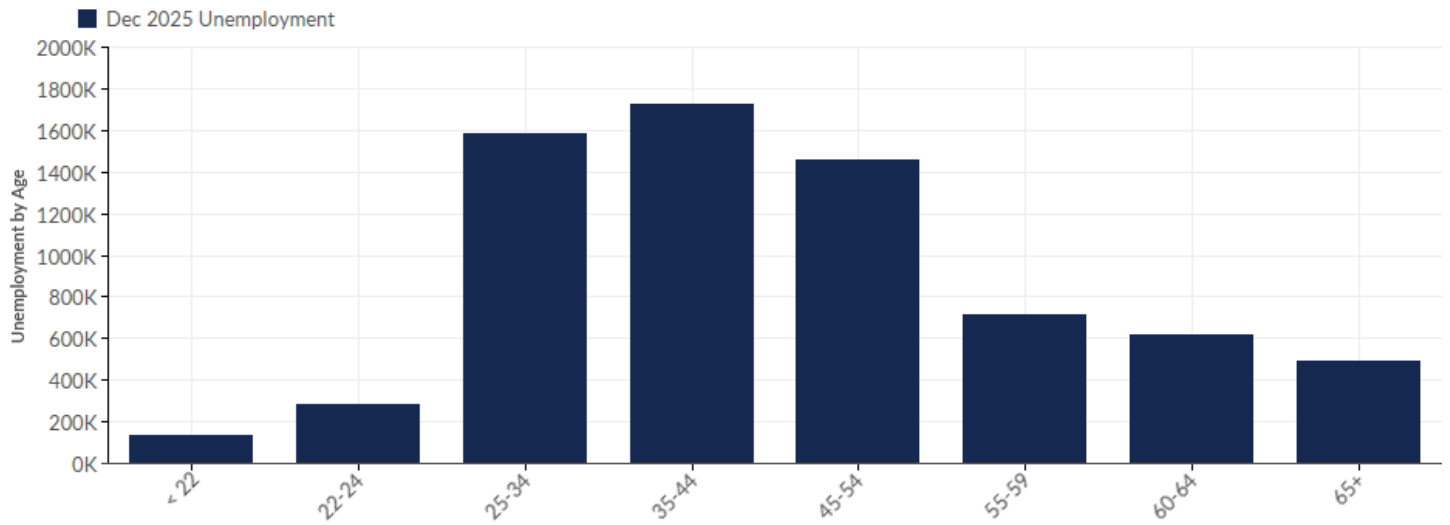
Educational Attainment

Concerning educational attainment, **21.8% of United States residents possess a Bachelor's Degree**, and **8.9% hold an Associate's Degree**.



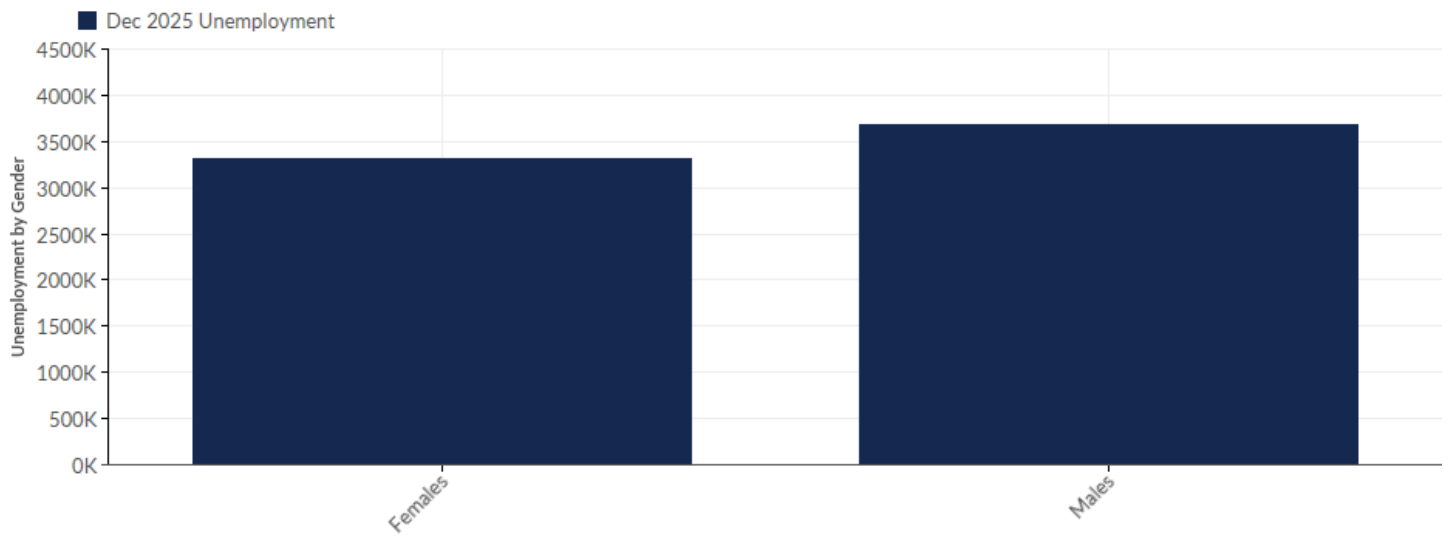

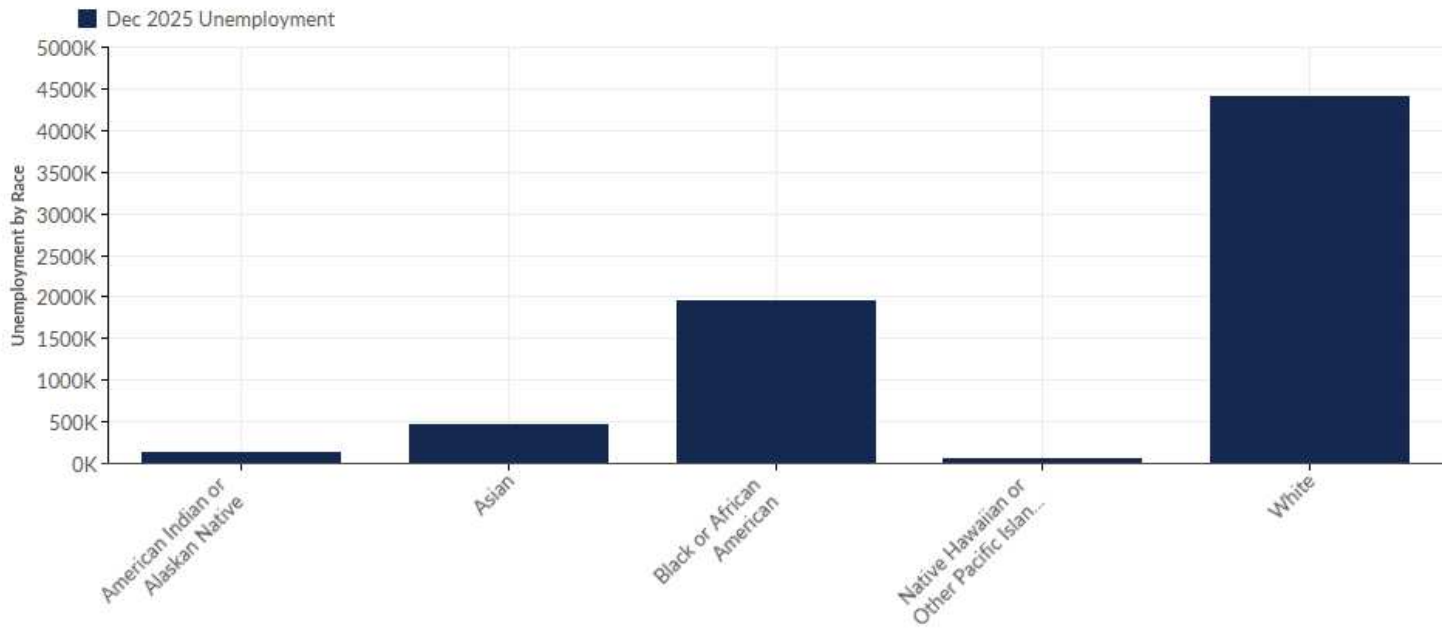

Unemployment by Gender



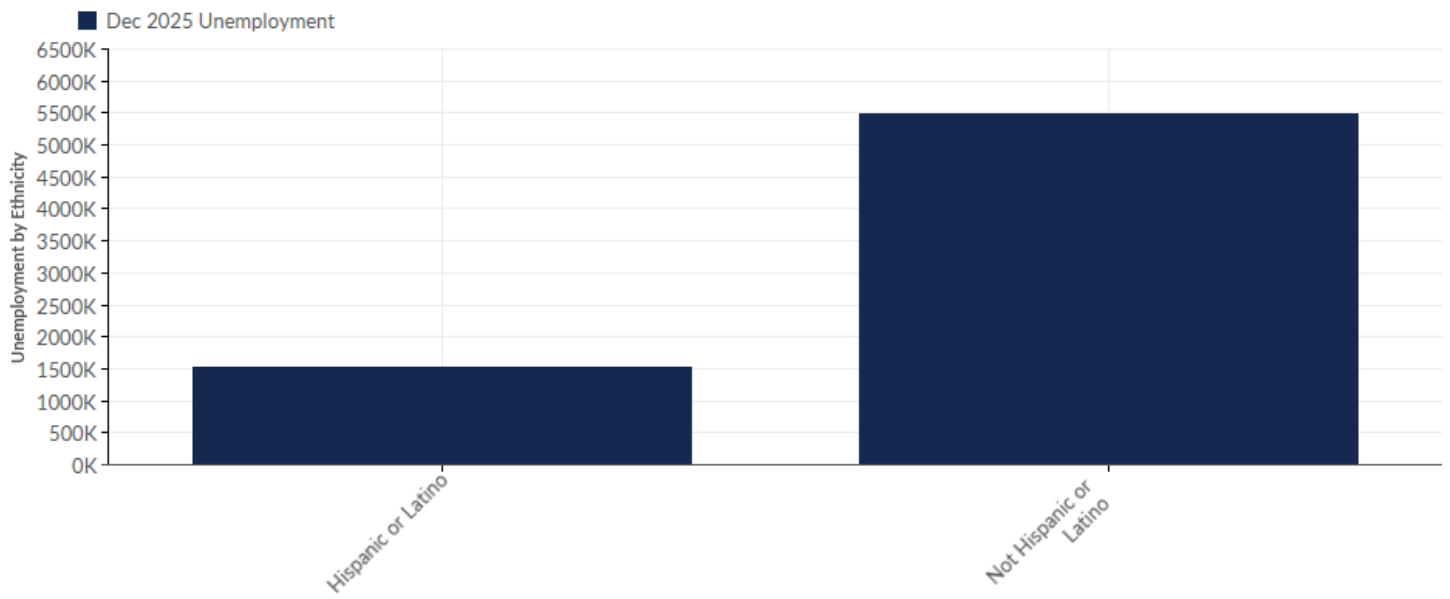

Unemployment by Ethnicity

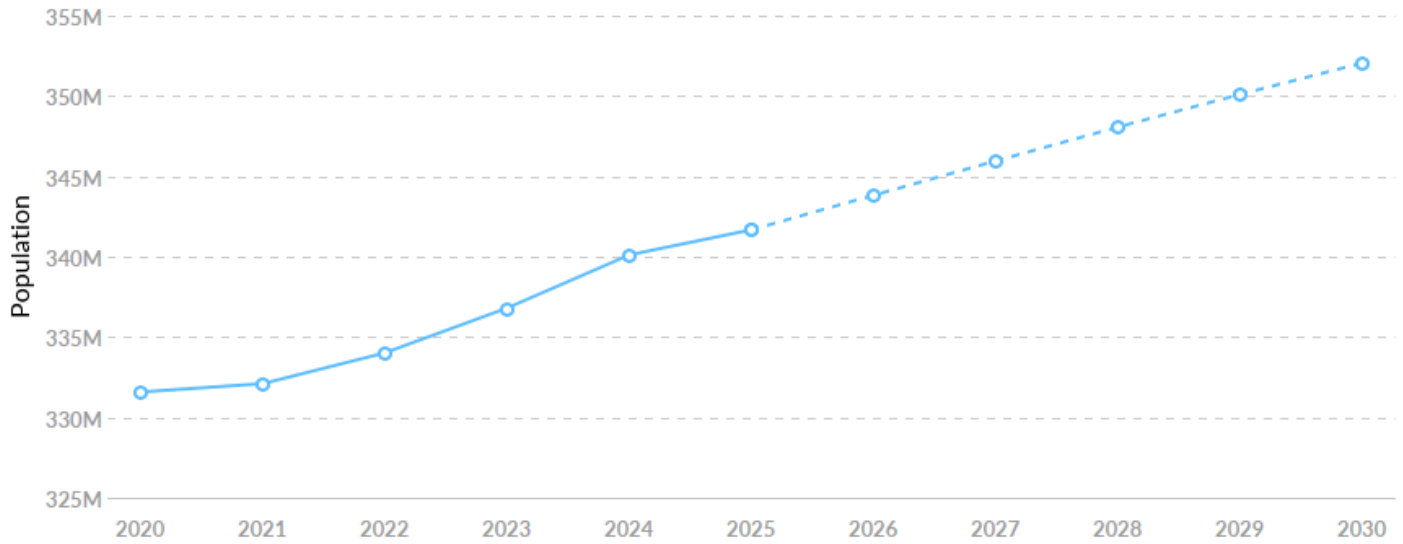

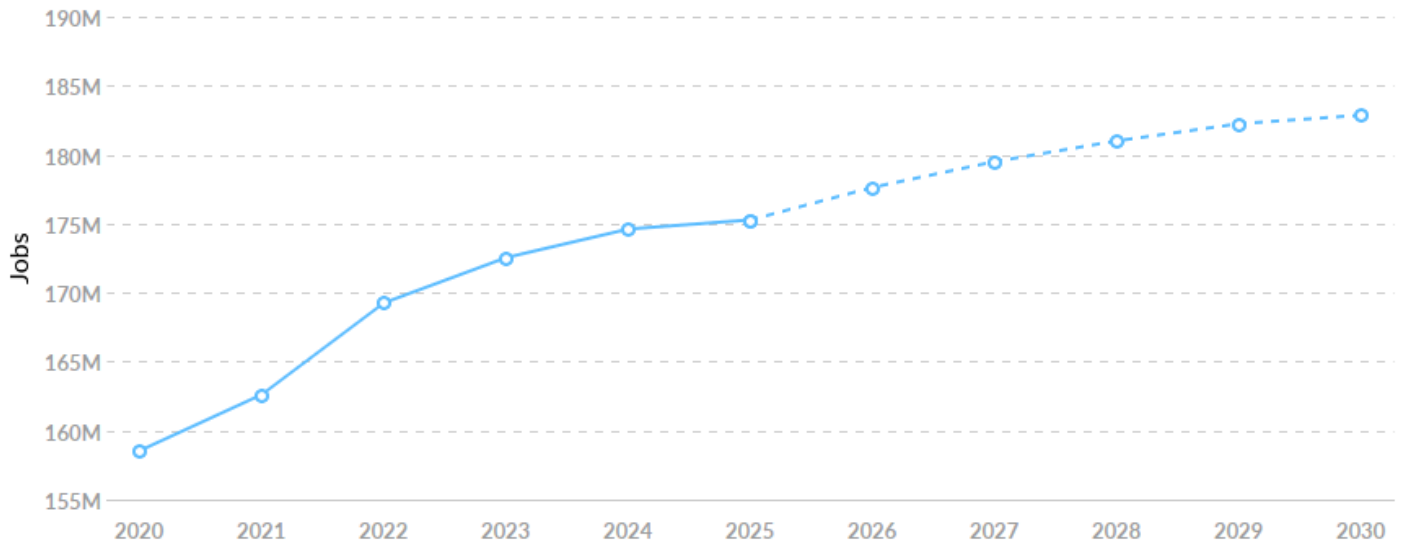

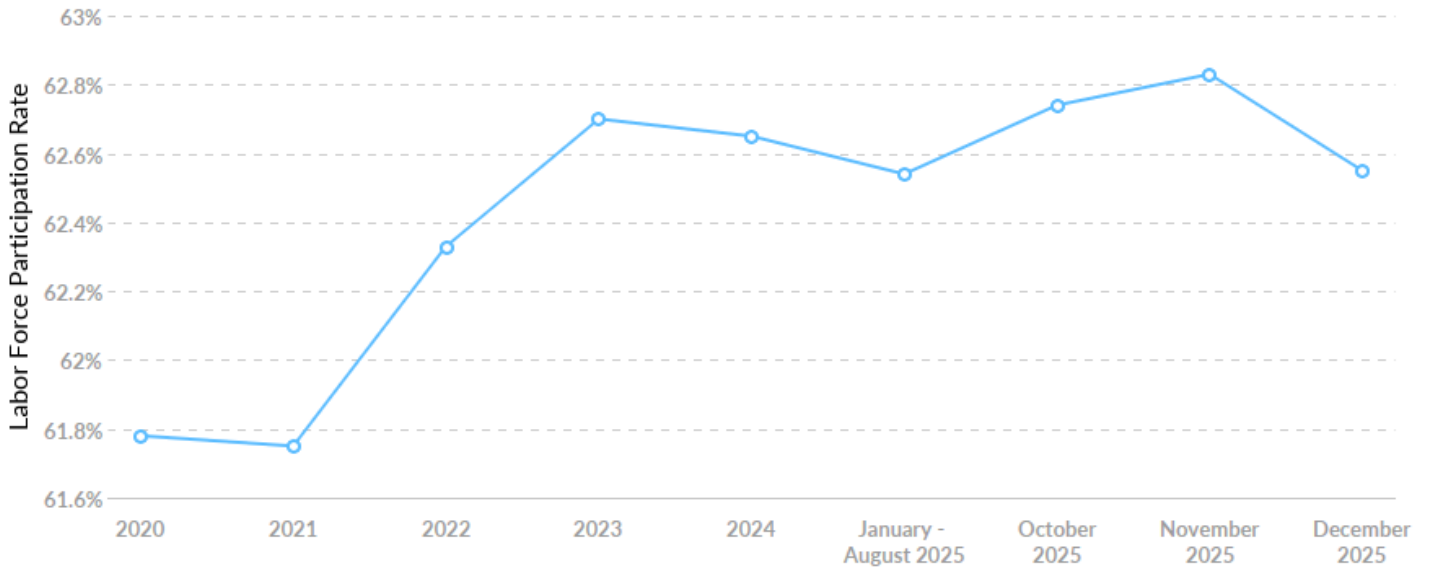

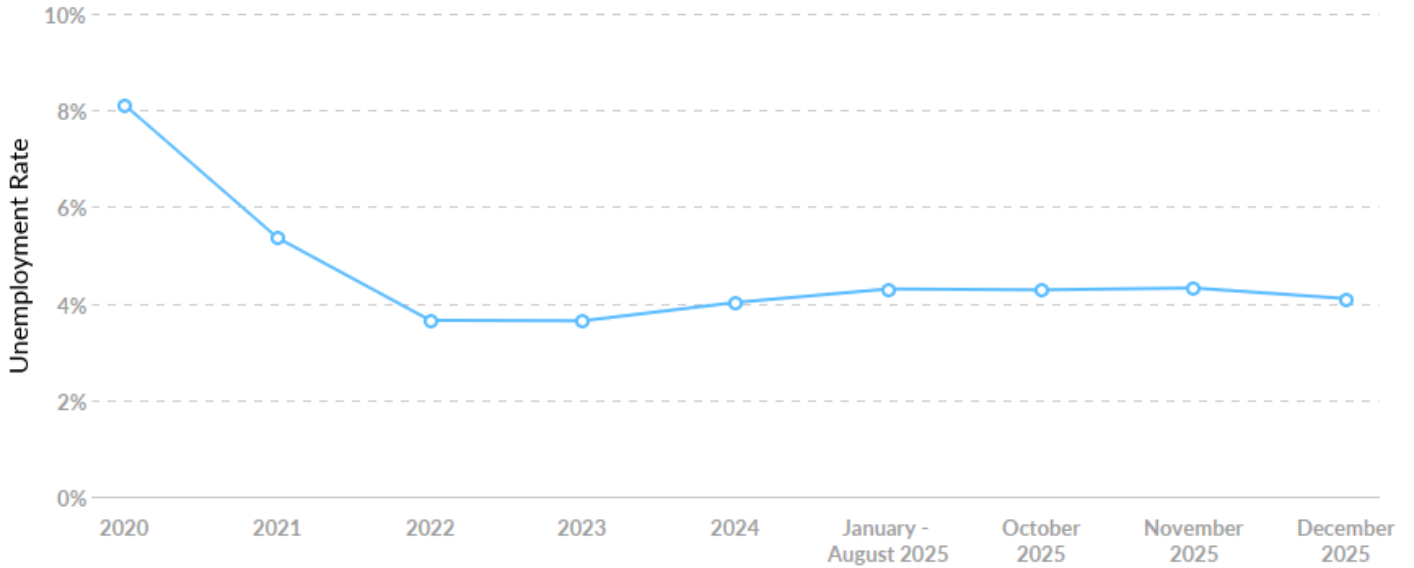

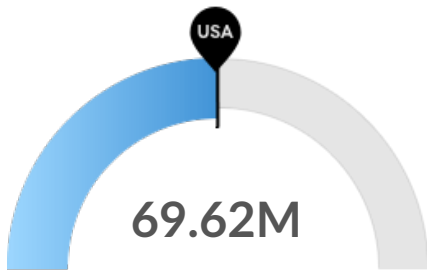

United States had a December 2025 unemployment rate of 4.10%, decreasing from 8.11% 5 years before.



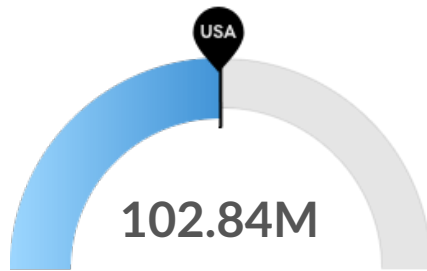

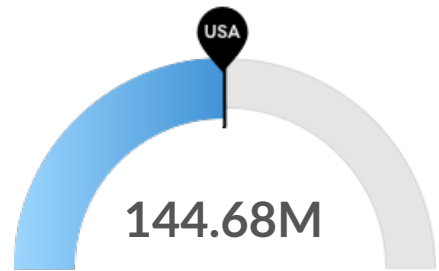

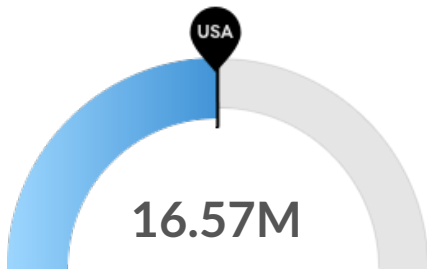
Retiring Soon

The United States has 102,841,643 people 55 or older.



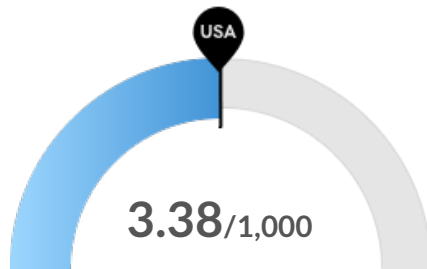
Racial Diversity

The United States has 144,677,764 racially diverse people.



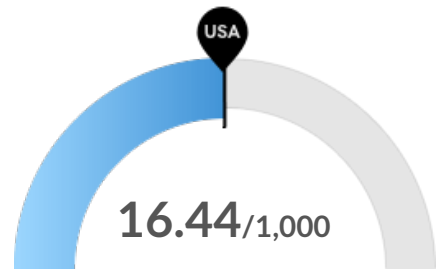
Veterans

The United States has 3.38 violent crimes per 1,000 people.

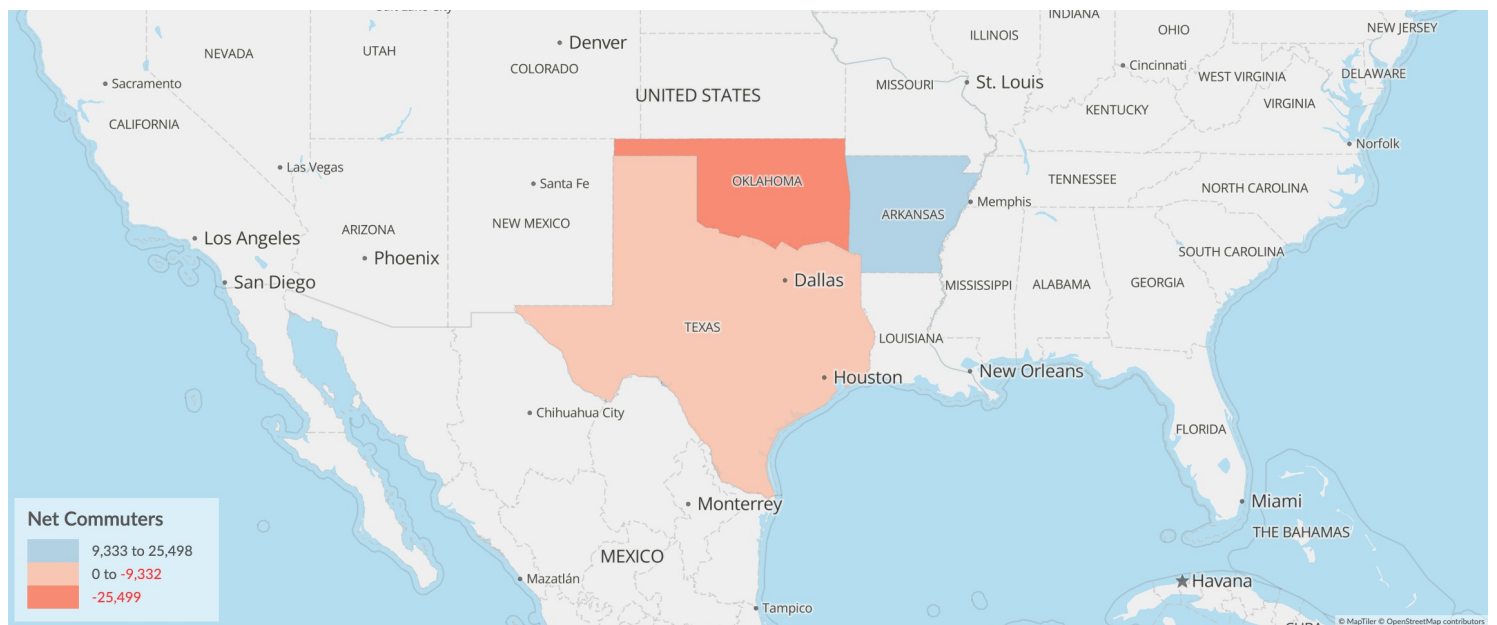


Property Crime

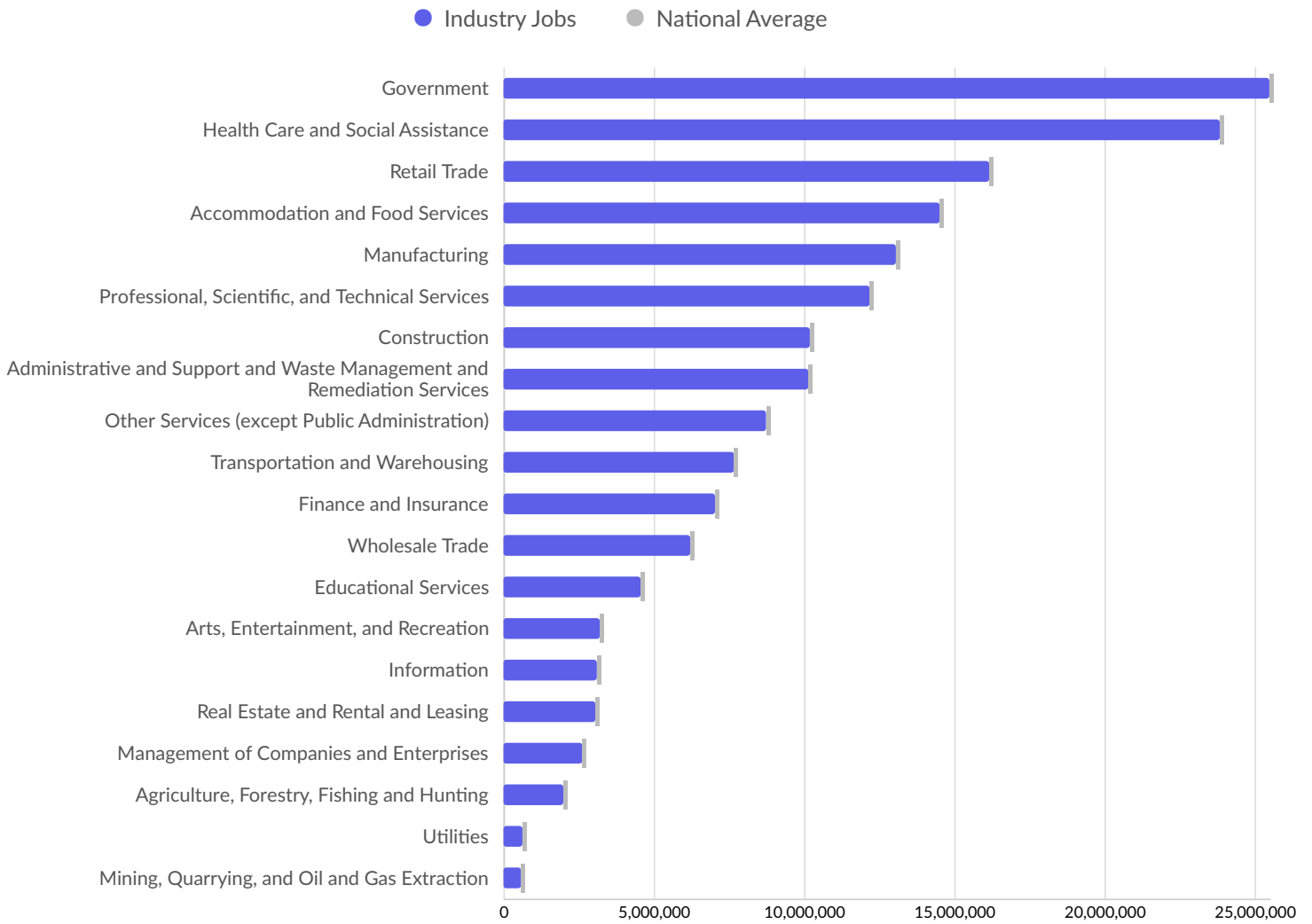

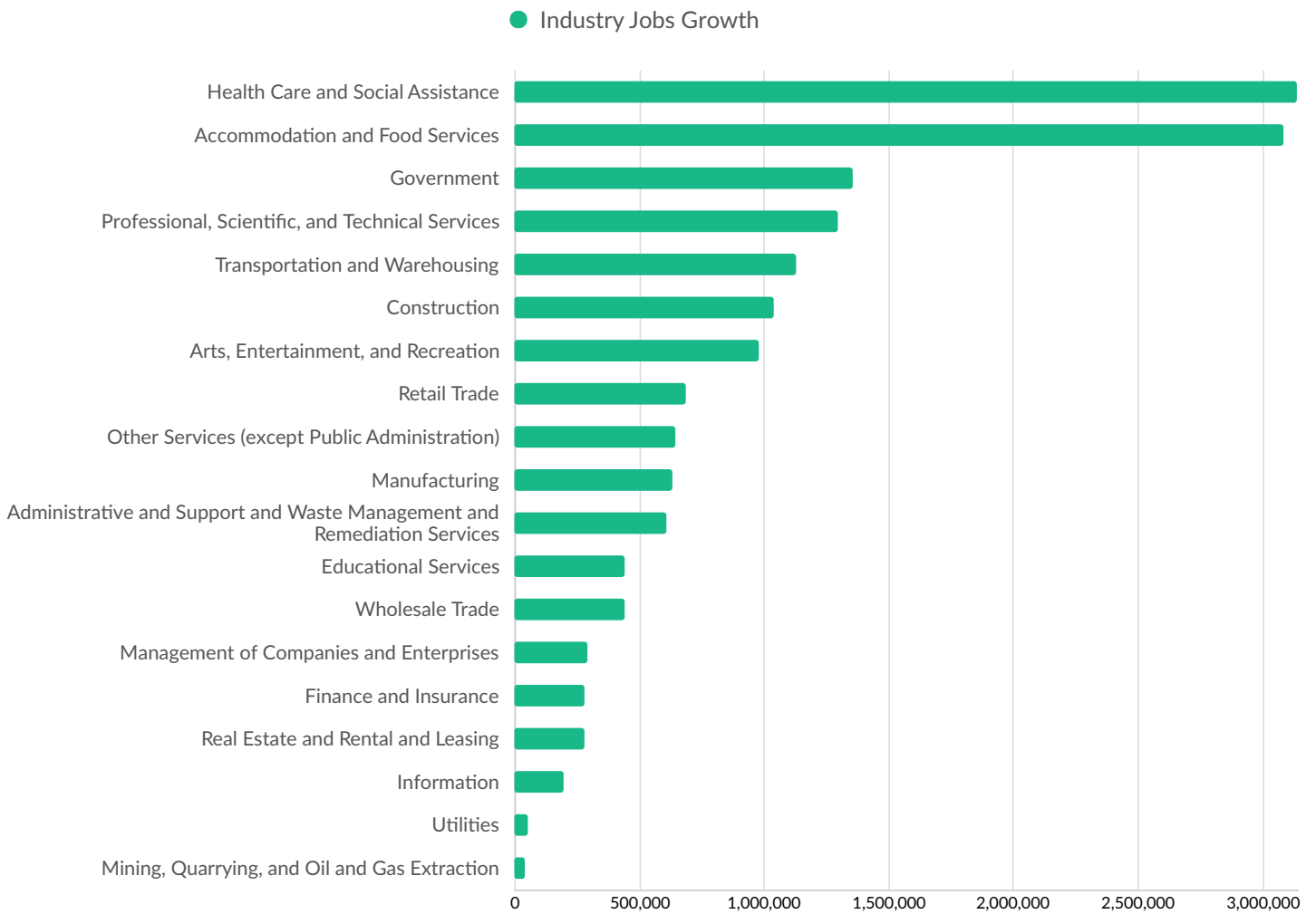

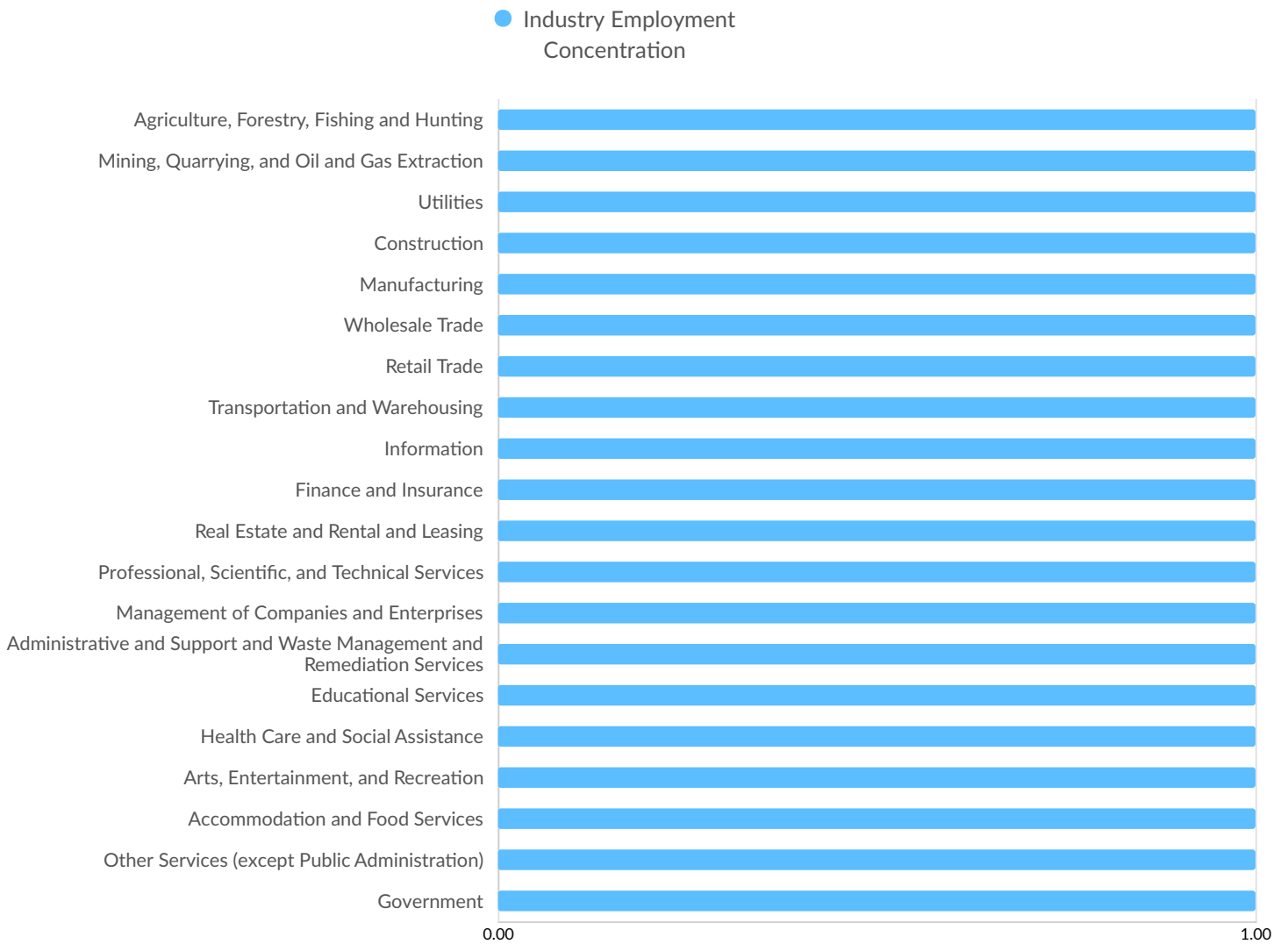

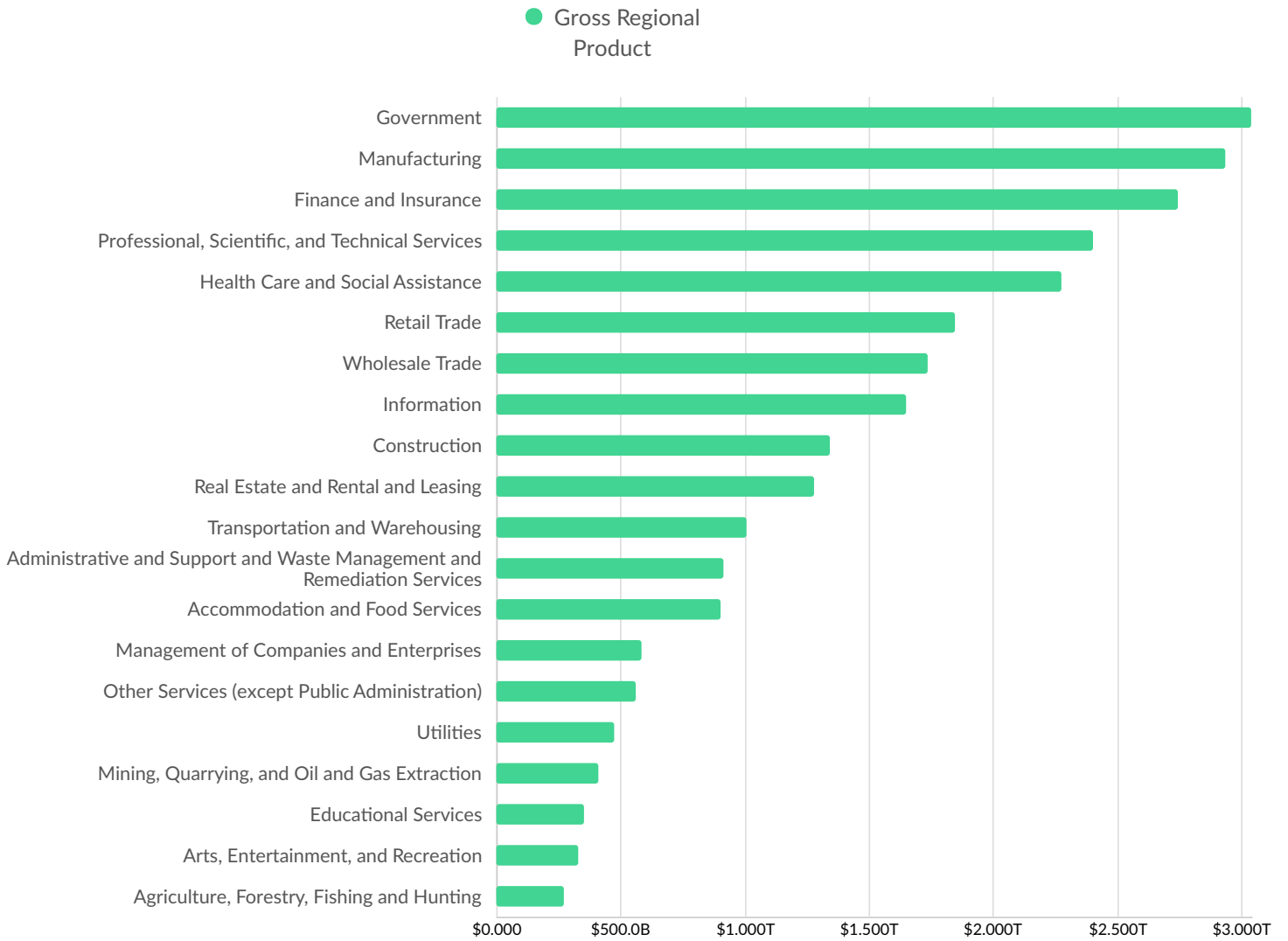
Top Growing Industries



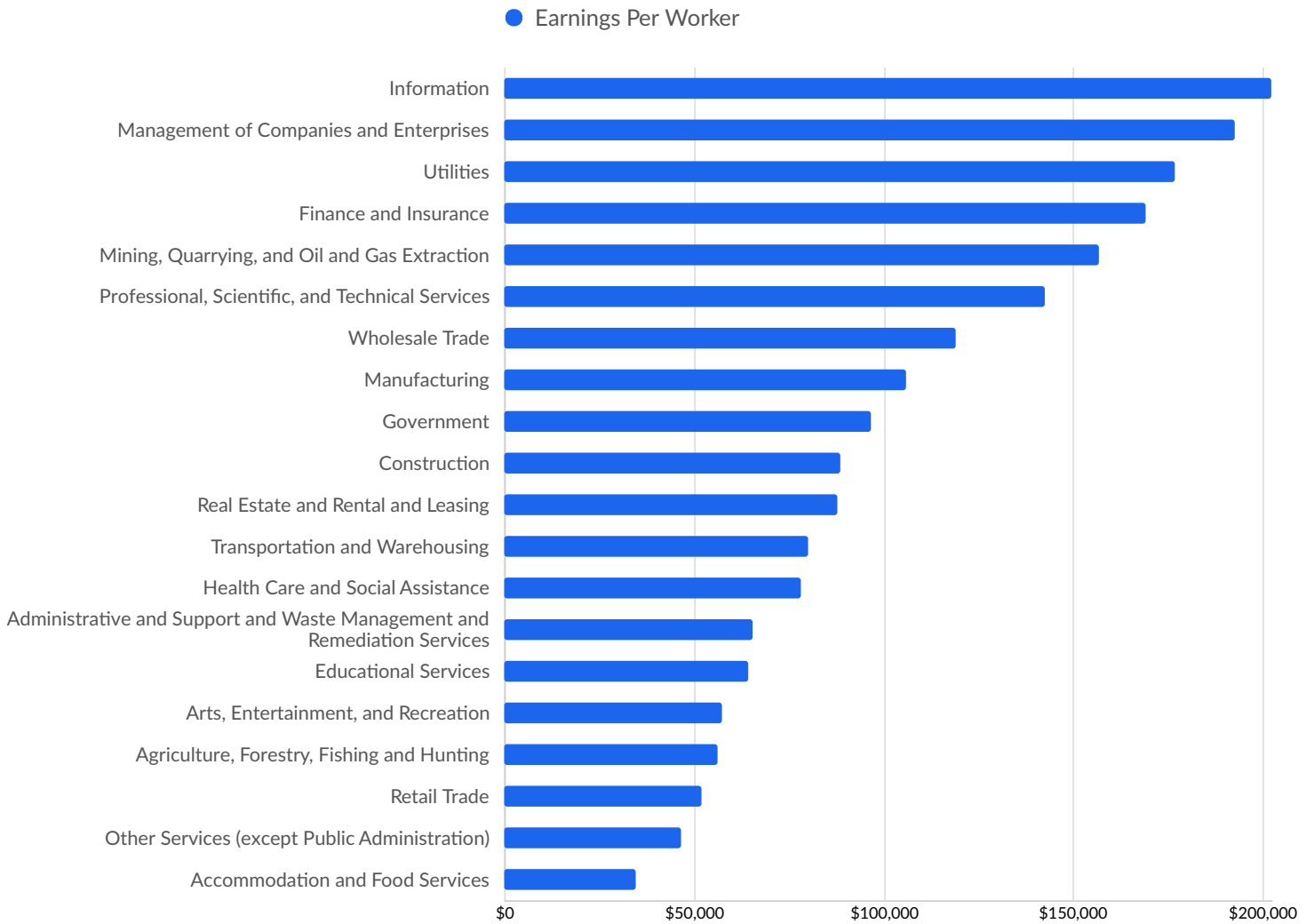
Top Industry Employment Concentration

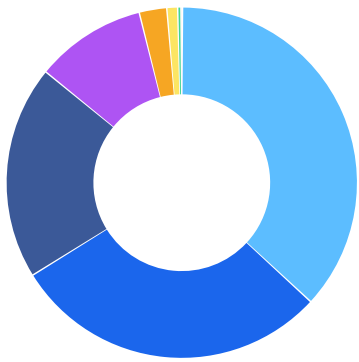

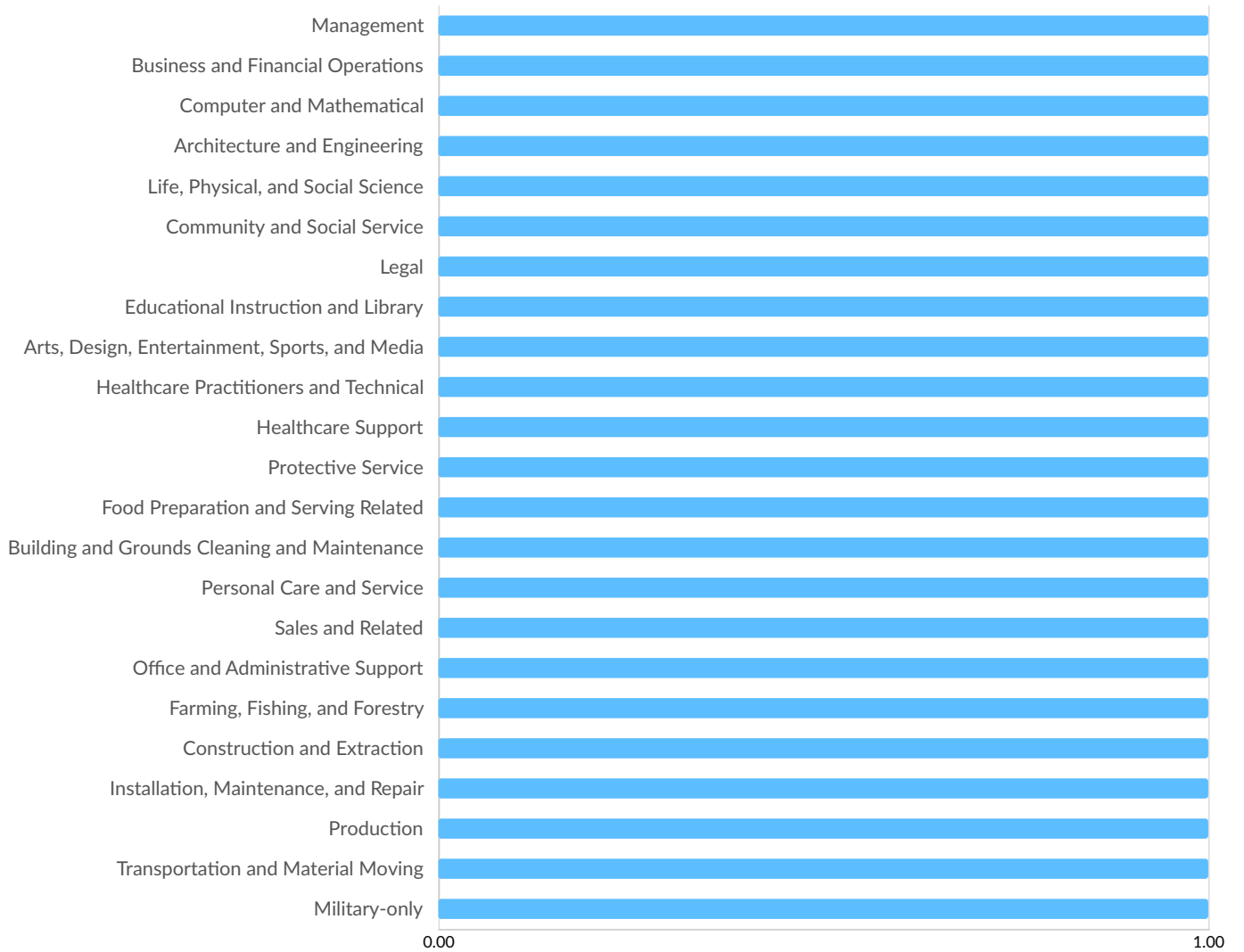

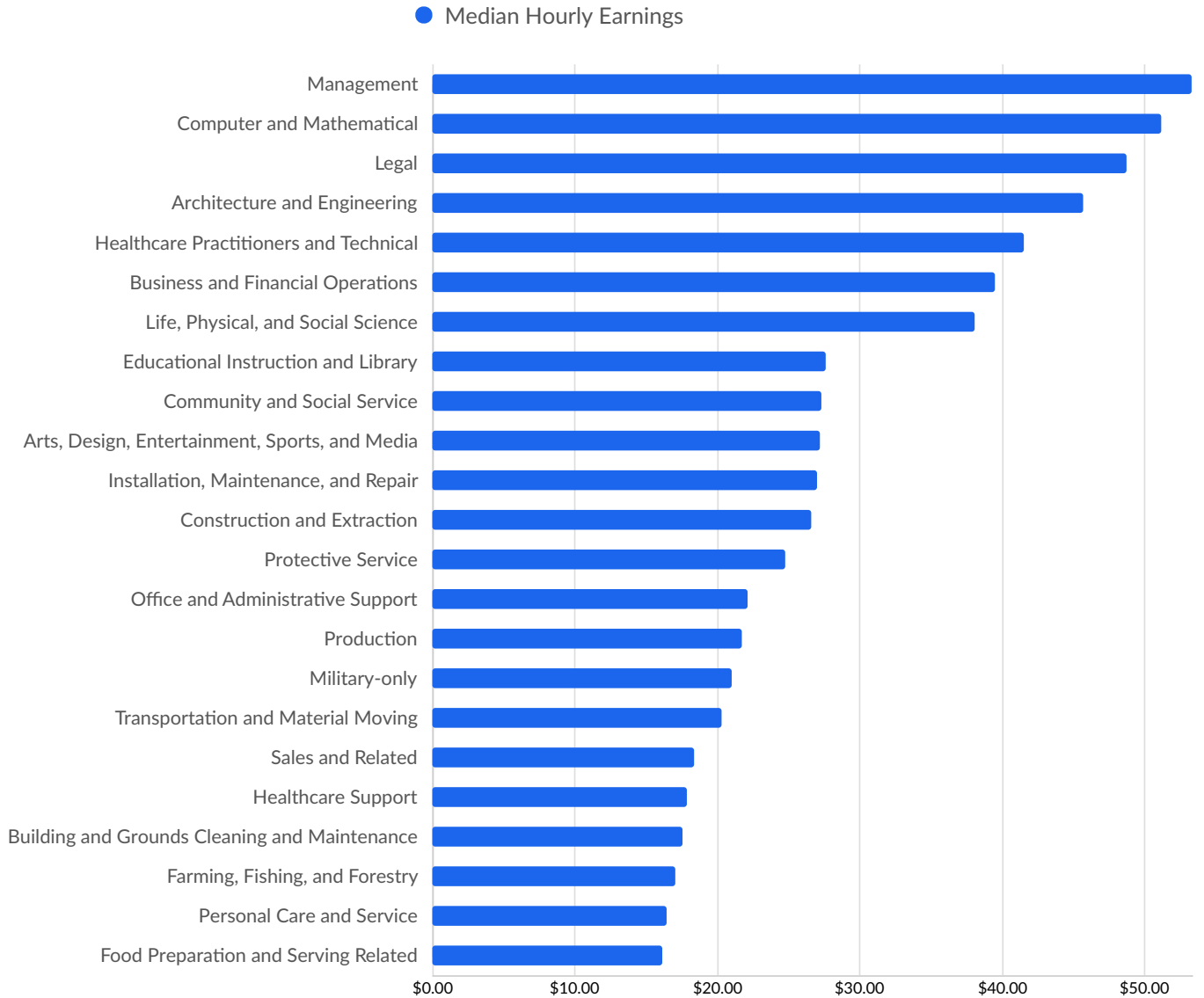


Top Occupation Employment Concentration

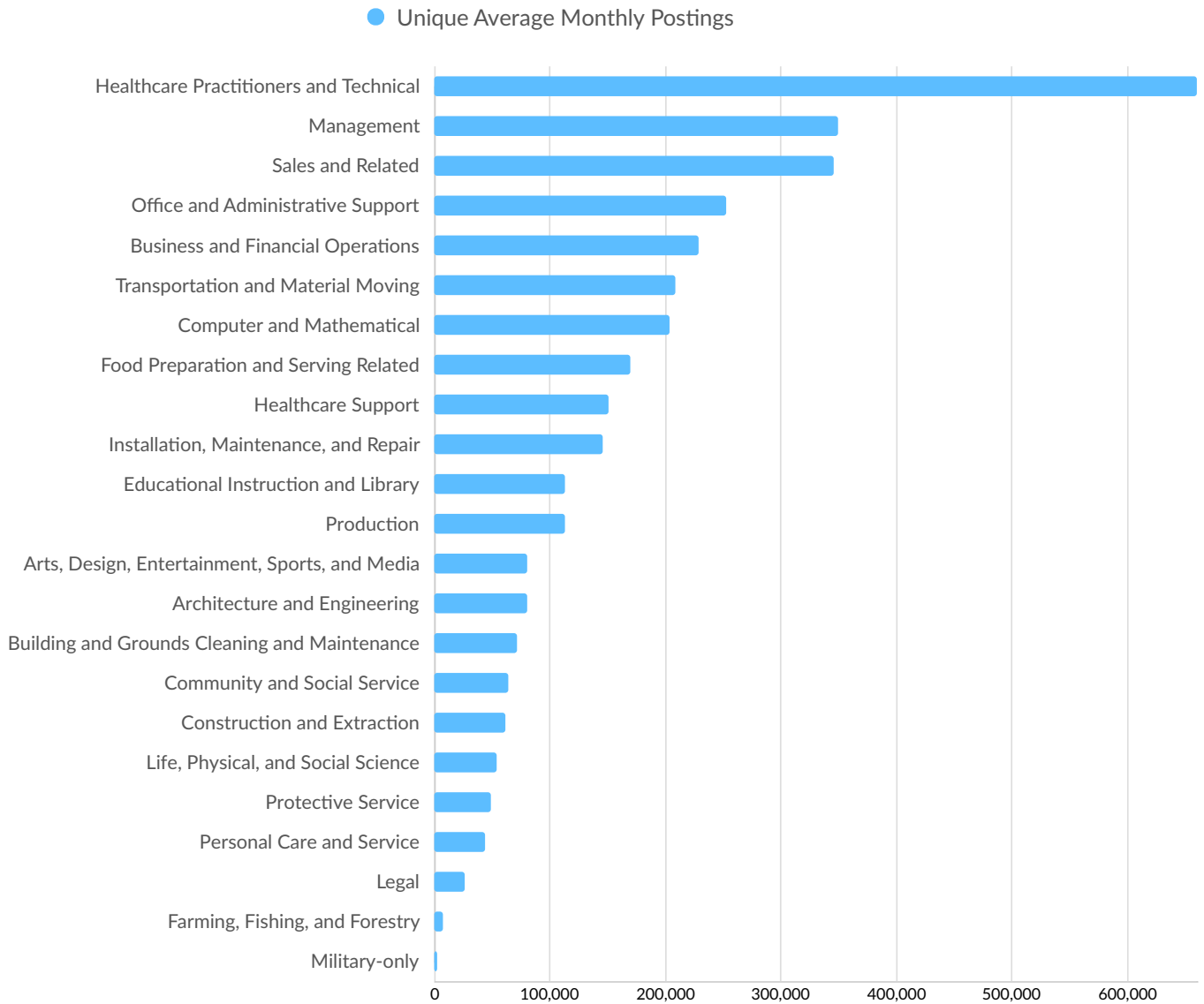

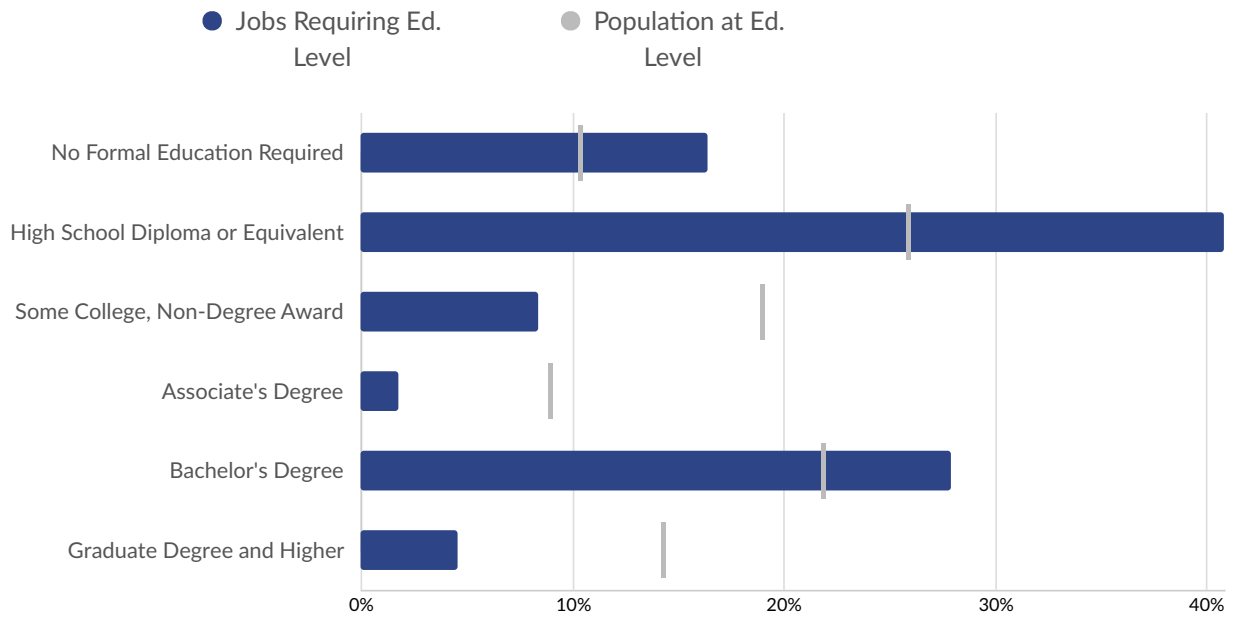
Top Occupation Earnings
